The theme of the show, "A Tribute to the American Masters of Music," was arranged by Brian, and was performed for the very first time for our audience. Playing and singing music from American composers from Steven Foster to Billy Joel, arranging the music to his own unique style. Brian performed for over two hours to the total delight of the audience. Brian's primary female singer and piano player is Katherine Alexandra, a graduate of the Moscow Conservatory of Music in piano and voice. Katherine is a very talented performer in her own right.
