Leroy's playing was so unique, clean and professional, and he could've been successful in Nashville, but he chose to have a family life instead of life on the road and settled in the St. Cloud area.

He was part of the house band at the Midwest Country Music Theater in Sandstone and his guitar licks were heard around the world via satellite television.

Glazier was most at home with traditional country-western, but could play jazz with the best of them.

Glazier passed away at the age of 66 from pancreatic cancer.
