**A Note from Rick:** Markets at TLA on Tuesday were unchanged for the most part. Slaughter markets were slightly lower. That is a first in many weeks for this market, which has been and remains very strong. Bull calves made another strong move upward. The top of the market was \$2.15/lb. and nearly half of the calves were between \$2.00 and \$2.15. This is a definite sign of a strong market when the spread between the mid to top is very slight. There is lots of demand. This is the opposite in weak markets which is where we are on the dairy side. The price difference between the top quality animals and the mid to lower quality animals is great. The one thing that has made a recent effect on the lower end of this market is the beef price which floors the market. The feeders did show more activity again, even with a light run. We've got a busy couple of weeks coming up with the Riding Horse Auction, Memorial Day Pony Sale and the two day Dutch Cross Classic.
