Actual funding for EYPP = £8,725.68 (includes £88.23 C/F from 2016 – 2017)

## Evaluation Report

### How the Early Years Pupil Premium was spent

This funding went towards supporting development and removing barriers to learning in all areas of the EYFS and narrowing the gap between EYPP and non EYPP in attainment and progress.

- Resources to enhance our writing activities £820.61
- Resources to support communication and language with a focus on speaking £2,096.19
- Oral Health Foundation toothcare packs for children (linked to wellbeing) £231.38
- Ice Cream van experience £142.74
- Contributing towards the cost of staffing to support small group work (spring term) £3,629.73
- Core books £1,805.03

### Evaluation of Impact of Additional Funding

- Enabled all children to take full advantage of all areas of provision within nursery, ensuring full access to all learning and enrichment opportunities.
- Additional resources targeted at speaking, reading and writing have helped remove barriers to learning and supported a large majority of children to make more than 3 steps of progress in these areas.
- Gap has been narrowed between EYPP and Non EYPP attainment.
