## STREET IMPROVEMENT ORDINANCE

## ORDINANCE NO. 36

An ordinance to provide for the allocation of the costs of the improvements within public rights of way within the Village of Dryden.

THE VILLAGE OF DRYDEN ORDAINS:

Section 1. Streets. The full cost of maintaining, improving or paving any street, road or alley shall be the responsibility of the Village. The Village shall pay such costs from Village funds or from special assessments.

Section 2. <u>Driveways</u>. The full cost for maintaining, improving or paving any driveway, apron or other private entrances onto Village Streets, roads or alleys shall be the sole responsibility of the benefiting private property owner.

Section 3. Other Improvements. The cost of any other public improvements within public rights of way, such as street shoulders or sidewalks, shall be the responsibility of the Village, provided the Village Council has granted specific approval for the work.

Section 4. Damage Repair. Any person, corporation or other party causing damage to public or private improvements within a street right of way shall be liable for the full cost of repairing such damage. Any damage to private driveways or sidewalks which is caused by the Village or any of its contractors shall be repaired by the Village.
