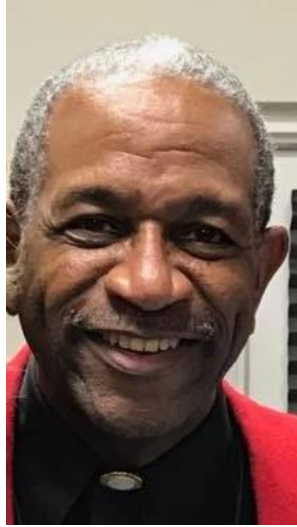


## Kevin Pullen
