

BACM Program Changes Due to Corona Virus

Food Pantry

To limit the number of people inside the pantry, volunteers will be serving clients drive-thru style at their vehicles. Follow the signs in the parking lot, pull up to the door, provide photo ID + proof of residency in the Barberton area (such as a piece of mail) + number of people in your household. Our pantry manager will log your information, while volunteers gather your food + a few toiletries. If you need a particular item, such as toilet paper or pet food, ask the pantry manager & if it is available another volunteer will bring it to your car. No need to exit your vehicle, just let the volunteer know where the items should be placed, such as trunk or back seat. Families can visit the pantry TWICE per month.

Senior Home Delivery

Food delivery on Thursday to our seniors is still available. Since many community members are home from work, we have additional volunteers that have allowed us to expand our delivery range to include Barberton, Norton, Clinton & New Franklin. Seniors age 60 & up must call by Tuesday at 5PM to register for Thursday delivery. A 3-day supply of food is available TWICE per month.

Head Start Back Pack Program

Since students are not in class, our back pack program is on hold. The Barberton City Schools are offering packed lunches to students at local parks.
