PC Petitions must be turned in by April 4, 2020

There have been many questions regarding PC Petition forms and how to complete the information on the top of the petition. See the following example:

I the undersigned, a qualified elector of the county of Maricopa, state of Arizona, and of LD23 YOUR PRECINCT and a member of the Republican party or a person who is registered as no party preference or independent as the party preference or who is registered with a political party that is not qualified for representation on the ballot, hereby nominate YOUR NAME who resides at YOUR ADDRESS in the county of Maricopa for the party nomination for the office of Precinct Committeeman to be

voted at the primary election to be held <u>August 4, 2020</u> as representing the principles of such party, and I hereby declare that I am qualified to vote

Our March 12 meeting will be very busy with the State Delegate election and 4 speakers. Please plan to attend and remember to bring your drivers license and a black INK pen (NO Sharpies). I strongly support the election of our PCs over other non-PC Republicans. My personal advice on voting is that you please vote for no more than 95 delegates/alternates, to avoid a lot of ties. Since there will be no campaigning in the building, please vote for the PCs you know.

Many of you have signed up to work at the Polls, in March, August and November. You may have signed up with different people, which is fine. We just need a list of all of the LD23 PCs who are interested in working the Polls. It is important that contact information is sent out to everyone when the County sends out notification emails. Please send me an email at ncordowski@gmail.com stating you are interested in working as a Poll Worker and that you have signed up with Arthur Cooper or Lynne Breyer or Linda Brickman. FIRST VICE CHAIRMAN - Rob Swoboda

I had the great honor to volunteer at the CPAC "America vs. Socialism" conference last week. I met and spoke with Eduardo Bolsonaro, member of Brazil's <u>Chamber of Deputies</u> and son of Brazilian President <u>Jair Bolsonaro</u>. Jair & Eduardo Bolsonaro are leading Brazil from the nightmare of Socialism to the freedom of Capitalism. Eduardo's speech at the Reagan Dinner described how free-minded, courageous Brazilians are engaged to free their nations from the shackles of decades of Socialism. You can watch the speech (https://youtu.be/L-uCZWK2ufM) and take special note at the 18.25 time stamp, when he says, "At the end of the day, socialism brings only death and starvation just like what you have in Venezuela." He ended by imploring us to not allow the election of Bernie and to vote for Donald Trump!

My conversations with Mr. Bolsonaro's staff after the dinner illustrated similarities between our President's victory over tremendous opposition and that of President Jair Bolsonaro. It was a clear reminder of the need to support President Trump and Republican candidates "down-ballot" with all of our strength. II. Speakers

Nancy Ordowski (LD23 Chairman)

- Welcomed guests, introduced elected officials and 2020 candidates present.
- Please turn in PC Petitions and nomination forms soon following all instructions.
- March 12th LD Meeting to elect State Convention Delegates and Alternates. Please attend. No proxies allowed. Bring government-issued photo ID for credentialing.

Arthur Cooper (Trump Reelection Committee) -

• Democrats are planning to challenge signatures on ballots. Signatures may change over time. If you have not registered in the past 5 years, do so again ASAP.

Rich Rutkowski (LD23 2nd Vice-Chairman) -

- Hike for the Homeless hosted by St. Joseph the Worker will be March 7th at McDowell Regional Park.
- Larry Schweikart, conservative historian & author of many books, will be speaking at Fountain Hills AZ Tea Party event on February 20

Stephen Richer (Candidate Maricopa County Recorder) – (Candidate Clair van Steenwyk was invited but did not respond.)

- Challenging Democrat Adrian Fontes for Maricopa County Recorder position.
