

Attic Accesses

Most attic spaces can be accessed through an opening. This opening can take many forms, the most common being a pull down stair, a walk up stair case, or an attic hatch. This opening is an area that if not properly insulated will be a big source of air leakage. We approach the different styles of accesses differently when it comes to insulation.

ATTIC PULL DOWN STAIRS

The attic pull down stairs is very easily insulated with an attic stair cover. At Divine Energy Solutions, we like to use the Energy Guardian attic stair cover. The Award Winning Energy Guardian eliminates energy loss. Proven, superior results due to R-39 insulating value, revolutionary air seal.



ATTIC HATCH

Similar to the pull down stairs the attic hatch also requires to be insulated. The most common way to insulate the attic hatch is with 2" polyiso foam board adhered to the back of the hatch. The foam board is taped with silver tape and the frame is weather stripped to prevent air flow.

ATTIC WALK UP STAIRS

In most cases the backside of the attic door will need to be insulated and the door itself weather stripped to prevent air flow. We do this very similar to the attic hatch with the 2" polyiso foam board and the silver tape.
