#### THE COMING OF THE LORD

Sermon By CHAS. F. PARHAM, Compton, Cal., December 30, 1925.

At the outset of this discourse. I want to present to you two schools of thought that have arisen in these latter days regarding the coming of the Lord. The first is the Post mil lennial view held by many of our super-intellectuals, evolutionary preachers who are not very anxious for the Lord to come and catch them in their salary grabbing professional non soul saving ministry. Once and for all the modern church should arise and drive from her midst every teacher and believer in evolution, for if modernism is correct they have no right to the claim of christian nor to live upon the gifts of the Christian church. Modernism with its evolutionary thought utterly repudiates the Bible. A denial of the creation according to scriptures, would mean that there was no fall, and if there was no fall the entire scheme of redemption through Jesus Christ our Lord becomes a farce, and makes the blood atonement as taught throughout the Bible absolutely worthless, and is the most dastardly Anti-Christian attack upon the Divinity of Christ ever perpetrated. The Post millennial view teaches that the world is getting better and better, that peace and harmony among the nations of the earth will be obtained by arbitration and not war, and that the late war with the roar of the cannon and the flash of the lightning clarified the atmosphere, making the world immeasurably better and that if the Federation of Churches can be accomplished with power to compel legislation along religious lines that the world can be saved and thus brought to Christ by law, and that in a million years the world will be so thoroughly converted and christianized by the power of these super-intellectuals that they will be able to invite the Christ to come and sit upon the Throne and rule the kingdom that they have thus prepared for Him. But brethern, the world will never be saved by law, we are saved by grace, and if it is not in the human heart to do right, you can never compel them to do right by law. Any reform for man's betterment however perfect or pure its motive and principles will be of no lasting benefit to the human

race unless it shall begin with the new birth, the regeneration of the inward man. A hog shaved will grow bristles again, a goose picked will grow feathers, the world if saved must be saved by the power of that new birth change of heart, regeneration of the inward man.

The opposite school is known as pre-millennialists who believe that the world is growing worse and worse, that the mid-night appro aches, the time of trouble such as there never was, that the door of mercy is now closing, that these nations are soon to fall, that this civilization has run its course and about to perish, and that Christ will come in the darkest hour of the world's history when He Himself said, "Would there be any faith on the earth?" and Himself establish the great millennial Sabbath. The latter school believes that this age is closing but not the end of the world. That ages come and go. Nations rise and fall, but the foundations of the earth are sure, they remain forever, and once and for all I want to state emphatically that the Coming of the Lord has no connection whatever with the end of the world. To the latter school of thought most all Full Gospel people and preachers closely adhere.

Regarding the next thousand or Sabbatic seventh thousand years there are two schools of thought, one is, that at the Coming of the Lord, Christ will take all His saints away in the clouds and the population of the eart utterly destroyed and the earth left for one thousand years. At the clo thousand years part of this school of believe that Christ will return to ea reign with His saints. The second so thought regarding the Sabbath to wh adhere is this, that a multitude of peo be slain in the judgments of the Lord th about to be visited upon the nations an those remaining upon the earth at the Co of the Lord will be lifted from sin and disc but not converted as Pastor Russell tau and that for the next Sabbatic thousand ye their lives will be lengthened as the life o tree, and dwelling under their own vine fig tree safely with none to make them afr the earth restored to Eden's Paradiscal esta where under the benign and benificent reig of Christ begetting children without hereditar taint in a world where the lion lies down with the lamb, the leopard with the ox, and the

child plays unhurt at the den of serpents, where the gold and silver is thrown to the moles and bats, (they are both blind and can't find it) where there will be no burning heat or bitter cold and all the fulness of perpetual spring, where man to man will be united, and all things before God righted, over which the Son of God, with His resurrected saints of the last six thousand years will reign in a glorious messianic-Christocracy when the earth shall keep her jubilee in that glorious golden age, prophesied by priest, prophet and sage, the millennial age.

When we speak of the soon Coming of the Lord, doubters say we don't know anything about it, that "since the Fathers fell asleep all things continue as they were from the beginning." "Where are the signs of His coming", they say. But Daniel tells us concerning these things that "the wise shall understand and instruct many." Jesus said, that when the fig tree put forth her leaves you know that spring is nigh, so that "When ye shall see all these things come to pass, know that the end is nigh, even at the door."

And truly all the signs from Genesis to Revelation that were to mark the soon coming of the Lord are now in the world, either having been fulfilled or else events proving that the world is pregnant with the possibilities of their immediate fulfillment. Again, Paul says," of the times and seasons brethern, ye have no need that I write unto you, for ye yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord cometh as a thief in the night," here they stop and hold up their hands and declare that we know nothing about it, but Paul continues by saying that when they shall say, "peace and safety", that sudden destruction shall come upon them. How true this is, for while the world is crying peace, peace peace, each nation is sitting upon a volcano which is liable to burst at any time, the streaming lavas of which may flow in raging war and anarchy to all the nations around about, so that Paul says, "Sudden destruction shall come upon them and they shall not escape." But listen, Paul says, "We are not in DARKNESS that that day should overtake us as a thief." Well, this and many other scriptures prove conclusively that the real children of God will know when the end is After presenting these opening thoughts I want to give you four of the most

indisputable proofs of the soon coming of the Lord, First, that as God labored and toiled six days and rested on the seventh, Barnabas who traveled with Paul says in his writings which are still in existence that this signifies that the human race will labor and toil for six thousand years (or six of God's days) and that then the Christ of God will descend in power and great glory and establish His kingdom on the earth for the seventh or sabbatic thousand years. God has sanctified the seventh part of time, the seventh day, then the seventh month, then the seventh year, then seven times seven and the Jews celebrated the year of jubilee and all slaves were set free and debts were cancelled so brethern, we are now closing six thousand years from Adam by all possible means of computing time whether you shall take it from bibical chronology, historical data or astronomical measurements. With absolute certainty we know that the Coming of the Lord is at hand.

Second. All scriptures agree that Palestine shall be trodden under foot of the Gentiles un til the times of the Gentiles be come in. That then the land would be wonderfully restored to the Jew.

The worlds war gave Palestine to the Jew, but under British protection. The imminent overthrow of England's government anticipated by noted men because of her labor difficulties would automatically free all of her colonies, making Palestine an independent state. The astonishing thing to me is that so many learned Bible exponents are blind to this stupen dous fact that the return of Palestine to the Jews means the end of the Gentile age, and in connection with this the Bible agrees that a time of trouble would set in, causing the Jews to flee "like doves to a window in a storm" back to their own land. Well truly the storms threaten over all the earth. Thirty five years of Bible study has proven to me that the close of the Gentile age will mean more than the return of Palestine to the Jew, these things are to take place according to the scriptures in connection with the closing of the Gentile age. The downfall of the present nations in anarchy. The utter perishing of this civilization, the closing of the door of mercy, the rapture of the saints into the heavens to meet the Lord who shall come secretly to snatch His own out of the time of trouble. The return of the Jews to

Palestine, which is to be followed by the establishment of ten States signified by the ten toes of Daniel and the ten horns of the scarlet colored beast of Revelation. These ten States will cover the present civilized world with the exception of what Russia will control. They will be a working men's, government. A United States of the world, a League of Nations, controlled by a commission of ten men, the present governments having fallen, the rich and ruling class destroyed, the masses will arise and establish a communistic United States over which the Anti-Christ will arise as a supreme dictator of a Socialistic kingdom, imitating the reign of Christ on earth, who will be destroyed with the brightness of the Coming of the Lord. This leads us to the third proposition. The indisputable fact that we have reached the midnight of the world's history, the time of trouble spoken of by Daniel. The fact that every nat. ion internally and externally is absolutely on their last legs. Impossible for them to navigate much longer. The greatest Statesmen of the world have declared that the continuance of the present nations is an impossibility, that we are headed to the overthrow of the present civilization, that anarchy, chaos and savagery threatens the world, within the present generation. It is a fact that all great nations and civilizations have not fallen gradually but precipituously, being plunged from the heighth of their political, intellectual and scientific attainment down to savagery and barbarism. All civilizations and nations that have existed in the past have been built up and around religion of one kind or another. So that when the people lost confidence in their religion, the priesthood were corrupted by money, the wealth was gathered in the hands of the few, and gross immorality swept the land, these civilizations and nations perished. Brethern, we are there today. The teachings of evolution in the grades, the high schools, colleges and universities is undermining and destroying the faith of the rising generation in God. Destroying their confidence in the Bible as the word of God, and the Christian religion is due to perish. what they thus teach in the schools of today will be the fact tomorrow. Half of the more intellectual preachers, schools, colleges and un iversities and most of the papers of the world have taken a stand for evolution against the Bible, and a person however intelligent who

dares to declare his faith in creation as taught in Genesis is looked upon and ridiculed as an ignoramus. The majority of ministers are mercenary grafters, professionals, prostituted by money, afraid to declare the whole counsel of God for fear of their salaries. The world at large has become grossly immoral, reaching down even into the grade schools. The wealth of the world is piled up by corporations and trusts in the hands of the few, so that all the diseases that caused the destruction of past nations are with us today. Leaving out Bible prophecies concerning this time of trouble if history repeats itself as it surely does, this civilization is doomed to perish. On reading the 5th chapter of James you will find that the rich are to perish for their oppression of the masses, according to many scriptures they are to be killed like dogs in the street, to throw their wealth away to get rid of the evidence against them, to cloth themselves in rags to hide their identity, and yet, the 5th chapter of James says they will continue to nourish their hearts as in a day of slaughter unmindful of their coming destruction. At this time, the children of God are to establish their hearts, be patient, withdraw themselves from the worldly and ungodly political revolutionary strife, etc., for the coming of the Lord is at hand. The business of christians is not to strive or seek to correct the affairs of the world for congress and Parliment are meeting with whitened faces seeking to balance empires that are about to perish. but let us as wise servants redeem the times which are evil by feeding the hungry, clothing the naked, healing the sick snatching men and women as brands from the burning. And lay up our treasures in heaven, where moth and rust, thieves and robbers, bolsheviks and profiteers ne'er come to destroy.

Fourth proposition: The world is astounded at the most phenominal movement in religious history known by various names, and being conducted by various leaders and organizations. Such as Apostolic, Pentecostal or Full Gospel. Which in 25 years has girthed the world and won to its standards ten million of people, great and small, learned and ignorant, and thousands of preachers who are today permeating every quarter of the world, carrying the restored gospel into isolated districts, villages, towns and cities. Holding services in the open air, in cottages, small halls, rickety store

buildings, tents, school houses, theaters, auditoriums and manificent temples costing over a million dollars. What meaneth this great commotion pray, ah! it is the fulfillment of that verse in the 24th chapter of Matthew where Jesus said that "This gospel of the kingdom should be preached to all the world as a witness and then the end would come." He did not say some creed bound gospel, or man made conception of the gospel or modernistic views of the gospel of this super-intellectualism that is seeking to destroy the blood atonement made on Calvary, but THIS GOSPEL OF THE KINGDOM, a gospel that saved the soul, sanctified the believer, healed the sick, cast out devils, raised the dead, baptised in the Holy Ghost, evidenced by speaking in other tongues and bestowed the fruits as well as the gifts of the spirit. A gospel that established universal brotherhood among believers and not a thousand divisions into denominations and clicks and gangs and bunches and answered the prayer of Jesus Christ that made them one even as He and the Father were one. You will note that Christ preached a kingdom, not a church. neither did He establish a church, nor was there a church inaugurated on the day of Pen. tecost. If there was such a thing as a church, Abraham and David and Jeremiah belonged to it, the fact is brethern, that the word church. did not occur in the Greek testament. Paul declares that His church or body is an spiritual house into which God puts the members as it pleases Him. And that God sets in the church Apostles, prophets pastors, teachers, miracles, healings, helps, governments and diversities of tongues. You could be voted into a modern church, initiated into a lodge, naturalized as a citizen of the United States or a citizen of the invisable empire of the Ku Klux Klan, but when you become a christian you a re born into an invisable Kingdom, for the church of Jesus Christ consists of all the truly converted people in all the churches and outside of all the churches, and nominal church membership don't amount to a pinch of snuff in a whirlwind and wont raise any more dust than that when these unconverted church members hit the middle of hell.

The world is amazed and astounded at the great sweep of this Full Gospel movement, but it should not strike them with such astonishment, the restoration of any truth ever preach-

ed by the church of the living God should be anticipated and received with gladness and not with doubtful disputations and persecutions. It is within the province of God and has been the hope of the Fathers since the days of Roman apostasy to see a restoration of primitive christianity. Luther hoped to accomplish it. Wesley did all in his power for its restoration, and with prophetic vision wrote, "Don't you hear them coming brethern marching up the steps of time. a glorious church without spot or wrinkle, washed in the blood of the lamb," adding to this the statement that the people of God who closed this age would have all the gifts and graces of the early church. Alexander Campbell who started the reformation that resulted in the christian denomination, said he expected the Christian church establishing unity among all believers to rise in all the gifts and graces in the early church. But now Brethern in spite of accumulated fanaticisms, wildfires, false teachings and Holy Rollerisms (which have always been prevalent in great reformations) we are witnessing a stupendous world wide, restoration of the faith once for all delivered to the saints. So that what Peter said, on the day of Pentecost can be joyfully anticipated, that "The heavens would receive Jesus until the restoration of ALL things spoken by the mouth of ALL the holy prophets since the world began. Witnessing the present restoration of ALL things spoken by the mouth of ALL the holy prophets gives us the assurance that the Coming of the Lord is at hand.

Thus we conclude the four most incontrovertable proofs of the soon coming of the Lord. There are many minor ones. Such as these, in the days of the preparation for the coming of the Lord, the chariots will rage in the street, run with a fearful din, jostle one another in the highways, run like the lightning with flaming torches. Here is a picture of our modern automobiles and electric cars. In the last days there was to be a new thing in the earth, a woman should compass a man, fulfilled by our new woman who is taking many of the positions formerly held by men, even the modern pulpits, so that when I see a woman going down the street dressed in men's attire and short hair and taking a man's job it forcibly reminds me of the soon coming of the Lord.

In closing this discourse I would like to present to you what I anticipate after many years

in the study of prophecy the events that are to take place between this and the Coming of the Lord. We are entering the midnight, or perhaps as the watchman says, the morning cometh, but also the night." For while the eastern skies begin to lighten with the rising of the Son of righteousness with healing in His wings, the darkest hour before the dawn is yet to cover the earth with the judgments of God, against a wicked and preverse generation who failed to recognize Him or give Him due worship. The accumulated sins of nations have fallen on a heap, for nations, like individuals, reap what they sow. The law of retributation is about to claim her own. The millions of sacrifices that have been offered upon the altars of nations in their imperialistic and commercial expansion call for vengence. The lust of power have caused wars, slaughtering millions. The saloons and the brothels wine presses of in iquity where millions of our sons and daugh, ters lives have been ruthlessly bruised out in the lust for money, and God has said that when your cities are run by blood, "I will destroy the nations," thus prophecy for fulfillment stands and all is ready for the sword of God. In the coming struggles of nationalism against internationalism or the rising tides of radicalism, the present nations will perish. The cities of the world will be destroyed. Not only will the nations fight each other, but factions and organizations within each nation will fight each other until every semblance of rule and order will perish. Governments will fall, lodges, unions, and churches will perish from the face of the earth. Property rights and the value of money will become worthless as the governments fall. Protection for home and life and property will cease. Angry mobs will surge through the land pillaging and ravaging families will be scattered and women and girls thrown into the street at the mercy of mobs. The rich be killed like dogs in the street. Well no better description than this can be given. The word of God says "that with fire and sword will He plead with all flesh until they will not be gathered or buried but be as dung on the face of the earth." In the opening days of this struggle the Jews will flee to Palestine carrying with them three fourths of the coinwealth of the world bankrupting every nation. The real saints of God will meet the Lord in the air the door of mercy will close and for the

last seven years of this age corresponding to the seven days in which God shut Noah in the ark there will be no one saved. Unprepared christians will be slaughtered in the days of anarchy, whose souls will remain under the altar clothed in white raiment until their brethern shall be slaughtered in like manner under the reign of Anti-Christ.

When the governments have fallen, when the rich and ruling elements of the world have perished, the Pope, the only power that controls sufficient of the conscience of men will call the combined forces of catholicism under arms and restore order. The masses alone will remain. At about this time a man will arise, a great teacher, a mighty intellectual, promulgating a new treatise on government and society. The world tired of war and bloodshed will flock to his standards. He becomes the intellectual guide out of bloodshed chaos and an archy. With the consent of the Pope all the now known civilized world outside of what Russia will control, will be divided into ten States. A United States of the world and a commission of ten men will govern these States. this has been foreshadowed by the Hague, the League of Nations, The World's Court idea and the thought of leading statesmen that no universal peace can be accomplished without a United States of the world.

Russia as the kingdom of the north which will take part in the battle of Armegeddon will in the coming days of anarchy, crush three ribs and extend her borders over all of Europe and Asia that did not belong to the Roman Empire, and under a dictatorship will continue to the end of the age. The rest of the world under the ten States as sort of working men's government will continue for three and one half years, but in the middle of the last week of years, this great intellectual giant, this great humantarian socialist who is so greatly beloved by the world because he accomplished the establishment of peace and universal brotherhood among men will be assassinated or wounded by the sword unto death, the world will wonder and mourn his decease as it never has on the death of any living individual. His dead body will lay in State at Jerusalem, but suddenly he comes alive, his spirit has really departed, but the eighth spirit to be using the body of the seventh great prince of the earth or rather the spirit of the Anti Christ the man

of sin the son of perdition will take possession of his body. In coming to life he will be accepted by the Jews as their Messiah, having fulfilled all their scriptures and their expectations as to what the Messiah would do in making Jerusalem the chief city of the earth and establishing a universal brotherhood. The Pope. the only remaining ecclesiastical power will declare Him to be the Christ, the Savior, and with the consent of the Jews will place an image of him in the rebuilt temple at Jerusalem. To him will be given power to perform all manner of miracles, even to make fire come down from heaven. He will be the incarnation of all this christian scientific, spiritualistic, theosophical, I AM, stuff. So that sitting in the temple of God, he is declared to be God. The exhaltation of the ego, the I AM, the self, so that the worship or edification of man is fast displacing the worship of God through the teaching of the above cults. The enthronement of the Anti Christ as the Christ will make him the worlds dictator of a socialistic empire, and an order goes forth backed up by the Pope who will become the false prophet of the Anti Christ, that you cannot buy or sell unless you have the mark of the beast and the number of his name in the right hand or forehead, this will simply be a reaction from universal brotherhood and the rule of a commune of ten men to a one man autocrat and one big union which will require, not a card or a badge but an absolute stamp in the right hand or forehead before they can transact any business and all will accept it who have ceased to worship God. Those refusing will be utterly slaughtered to join the white robed martyrs who are resting under the throne. History repeating itself will make it easy to understand this exhaltation of the Anti Christ. When Rome could no longer stand, the rule of the rich and the iron heel of the tyrant they arose and killed the ruling class and slaughtered the rich. Establishing the plebiscite, out of which arose Ceasar the dictator. When France could not stand the same condition they guillotined the aristocrasy slaughtering the rich, and establishing the Commune out of which came Napoleon the dictator, when Russia could not stand the bloody rule of the Czar she arose and slaughtered the rich and killed the ruling class, bolshevikism resulted, out of which will come a dictator who will rule to the end. When the rest of the nat-

ions can no longer stand the rule of the rich, of profiteers, they will rise enmasse and anarchy or the time of trouble will ensue followed by the establishment of ten States in a workingmens government out of which will arise the Anti Christ as the worlds dictator. The battle of Armengeddon closing the age will be the result of the two great dictators ruling the world, one in Russia the other from Jerusalem, aspiring to worlds wide power or one man rule in the world. Their forces will push one at the other until Russia gathering all her militarianistic powers will pass south, east of the Jordon into Egypt where gathering the forces of Etheopia with her she turns back to utterly destroy the power of the Anti Christ in Jerusalem, who has gathered for his defense all the military power of his kingdom. The King of the north lays siege to Jerusalem, part of the city is taken, the houses riffled, the women ravished, at this juncture the heavens open and the Christ the King of glory begins his majestic descent. The scriptures imply that an armstice is signed between these contending forces and together they unite their forces in the Valley of Megeddo awaiting the descent of the Christ of God. His foot touches Mount Olivet, it splits in two, toward the north and the south leaving those who come with him in the valley made by the rent of the mountains and He passes down to the battle field alone, destroying the fighting forces of the world in one great battle. Triumphantly returning to the city of Jerusalem He will cleanse and purge the earth and with His resurrected saints in immortal, incorruptible bodies will reign over the entire world from sea to sea and pole to pole for the next thousand years.

### JUDAISM SHAKEN TO ITS FOUNDATION

Rabbi Wis's statements regarding Jesus the Christ bids fair to lead many of the Jews to accept Christ.

Jews from babyhood have been taught that

Christ was a myth and not a man. Dr. Wise now states that He was a teacher, a prophet, and that they accept Him as one of the world's greatest teachers, rejecting only His claims to be the Son of God. Dr. Wise's position as perhaps the greatest teacher among the Jews today, and as head of the great Zionistic movement lent tremenduous emphasis to his state-The daily papers have been full of it. Great Rabbi's have commented upon it. Orthadox Jews have resented it. Reform Jews have heraled it as a great step toward advancement toward liberty of thought among the Jews. It really opens the way for a union Jewish congregations with many so called christian congregations, such as Unitarians who reject the Divinity of Christ and only accept Him as a great teacher.

No such controversy has ever shaken Judaism. Practically every synagague in America heard discourses upon this particular point last Sunday. The case of Dr. Wise has profound bearing upon the future of religious life. The statement of leading Rabbis is here—with appended.

Rabbi Dudolph Grossman, preaching in the temple Roepph Sholon pleaded for tolerance and a true understanding of one another that is born of sympathy and genuine knowledge. He said:

"Whether a man be a Christian of a Jew, Buddhist or a Moslem under a different name; it is the same truth he seeks, though along different paths; it is the same happiness that he desires, through it be clothed in a different garb.

Rabbi Maurice H. Harris at the Temple Israel said: Judaism and Christianity have an intimate and indissoluble relation. History fails to show any other instance in which two separate religions are so closely linked."

Dr. Samuel Gup of Providence, said: When Rabbi Wise tells his congregation that Jesus was a man, he is not precipitating anything new and startling upon Judaism.

That there are Jews who believe that Jesus was a man and not a myth does not constitute an issue upon which Jews need fear a new modernist-fundamentalist debate."

Rabbi Samuel Hirschberg at Temple Emanu-El, Milwaukee, entered the conflict with the assertion; "I have no doubt of the historic reality of such a person as Jesus of Naz areth."

Rabbi Samuel Yalon of Syracuse said: "Rabbi Wise is absolutely wrong in his view and interpretation of Jewish opinion about the Nazarene.

Rabbi Benjamin Fried of the same city differed with this opinion; "Rabbi Wise and I hold the same view points about the position of Jesus of Nazareth in the religious realm. The Jews recognize in the teachings of Jesus the teachings of our own rabbis.

### EVOLUTION

## THE FIRST COVENANT WITH PROMISE -OBEY THE VOICE OF GOD

"Thus saith the Lord of hosts, the God of Israel; Put your burnt offerings unto your sacrifices, and eat flesh, For I spake not unto your

fathers, nor commanded them in the day that I brought them out of the land of Egypt, concerning burnt offerings or sacrifices; But this thing commanded I them, saying, OBEY MY VOICE, and I will be your God, and ye shall be my people: and walk ye in all the ways that I have commanded you, that it may be well with you." Jer. 7:21, 23.

These are the words of God to Jeremiah, to be delivered to the children of Judah at Jerusalem. God is calling them to mind that he did not speak about burnt offerings or sacrifices when he spoke to the children of Israel with his own voice, the whole congregation being gathered together at the foot of Mount Sinai to hear God speak, and when they heard God's voice they were exceedingly afraid and as soon as God had finished speaking the Ten Commandments they drew away and told Moses to go near and hear what God had to say to them, and he could tell them and they would do it. This was really not the first covenant that God made with them, but the one he was about to make was the only one he ever made with them direct, speaking to them by his own voice. The promise of a covenant was made through Moses and the condition was, if they would obey His voice. They had not heard it yet, but sent word by Moses, saying, "All that the Lord hath spoken we will do." Then the Lord proceeds to make arrangements for them to meet with God and hear his voice. The arrangements were all made according to the nineteenth chapter of Exodus, but the record of what God said to them is recorded in the first part of the twentieth chapter. God started off by introducing himself, saying, "I AM THE LORD THY GOD WHICH HAVE BROUGHT THEE OUT OF THE LAND OF EGYPT, OUT OF HOUSE OF BONDAGE." Thus he was telling them just who he was so there would be no mistake about whom they were listening to. that they might consider what was spoken, always. Then God called Moses up into the mount and gave him a written copy of what he said. and told Moses to put it in the Ark.

When they asked God not to speak to them any more He promised to send them the prophets who would speak for him, and told them, "Not to touch his anointed, and to do his prophets no harm." That is the reason he sent them prophets to make his will known to them, and the prophets were in reality delivering to

them the VOICE OF GOD. And they had promised to obey the voice of God, but they did not do it, and God made them pay for their rebellion.

God also promised them a special prophet that would tell them all that he would say to them. It is recorded thus, "The Lord thy God will raise up unto thee a prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken; According to all that thou desiredst of the Lord thy God in Horeb in the day of the assembly, saying, Let me not hear again the voice of the Lord my God, neither let me see this great fire any more, that I die not. And the Lord said unto me, They have well spoken that which they have spoken. I will raise them up a prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and I will put my words in his mouth; and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him. And it shall come to pass, that whosoever will not hearken unto my words which he shall speak in my name, I will require it of him." Deut. 18:15. 19.

When Peter quotes this passage in his discourse to the people at the Temple just after the healing of the man who was impotent in his ankles, he says, "For Moses truly said unto the fathers, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethern, like unto me; him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you. And it shall come to pass, that every soul, which will not hear that prophet, shall be destroyed from among the people. Yea, and all the prophets from Samuel and those that foilow after, as many as have spoken, have likewise foretold of these days. Ye are the child. ren of the prophets, and of the covenant which God made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, And in thy seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed. Unto you first, God, having raised up his son Jesus, sent him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities. Acts 4:22, 26. Jesus said the words which he spake were not his words, but the words of God the Father who sent him. John 14:24. They were in reality the voice of God. And as much as we are the recipients of this covenant, these words apply to us, they

are the voice, or the words of God to us. THE VOICE OF GOD.

God is still speaking by the Holy Ghost through those who are filled with the Holy Ghost, the same as the Apostles were. When the Holy Ghost speaks it is the VOICE OF GOD. Jesus said, "Take heed how ye hear." God speaks today to those who are near and dear to him, the same as he always has, as he did to Jesus, and to the Apostles. ### SUBDUED

Before God can launch us out into the breadth and sweetness of His service and entrust to us great things for Himself, we must be perfectly subdued in every part of our nature to His will and the disposition of His mind. We must be subdued in our hearts, in our wills, in our words, in our tempers, in our manners; subdued through and through so thoroughly that we will be flexible to all His purposes and plans. We must be so subdued that harshness, severity, criticism, sluggishness, laziness, impetuosity and all wanting our own way even in religious matters, must be subdued out of us. Conversion will not finish this work, and perhaps not in one case out of a thousand will the second work of grace produce this complete condition of teachable sub. jugation to God's Spirit. Being able to preach strong sermons on sanctification will not do it. or having charge of camp meetings, or conventions, or Bible schools, or the writing of books and editing papers on Christian holiness will not prove adequate for this grace.

We must be subdued not merely in our own opinion, not merely think ourselves subdued but subdued so perfectly that the allseeing eye of God can look us through and the omnicient One knows that we are subdued. God must conquer the man that He can trust with His great thoughts and plans.

The Holy Ghost must saturate us with a divine conquest before He can use us to conquer other souls. The Lord will begin to sub due us with gentle means, and if we sink lovingly and promptly into His mind, the work will

be done but if we have flint or iron in our nature and it is necessary. He will use heroic means and put us between the millstones and grind us to powder, until He can mould us without any resistance to His purpose. The greatest difficulty in the way of God's using His servants, even His zealous and oftentimes sanctified servants, is that they are not perfectly, universally, and constantly subdued under the power of God.

We must be so subdued as to stop meddling with other people's matters that God has not entrusted us with; so subdued as not to be calling God's servants hard names, and thrusting at Christians who are doing what they can in their various fields for the Master; so subdued that we can hold our tongues, and walk softly with God, keep our eyes upon Jesus, attend to our own work, and do God's will promptly and lovingly, glad to have a place in His kingdom and to do a little service for Him.

Oh! it is grand to be absolutely conquered by the Holy Ghost, and swing out a thousand miles from everybody and everything into the ocean of God's presence, and work with Him in humility, without chafing, without fault-finding, without stumbling over others, without religious peevishness, and bend with every plan that God gives to us.

When we are subdued in the sight of God, He will work miracles in us and through us: miracles of mercy and power in experience, in healing, in finance, in opening doors, in widening the fields of service, in gentleness and sweetness of the inner heart life, miracles of grace that will astonish us and surprise our friends and utterly amaze our enemies when they come to know the magnitude of what God has wrought. Let us get subdued in every way, in everything; so subdued that we can keep still in God and see Him work out the great, bright thoughts of His eternal mind in our lives.—Author Unknown.

### THEY NEED CHRIST

In a life of Ramabai written by Helen S. Dyer this picture is given of a child-widow and the following description.

"This poor little child, married at the age of five to a man forty years her senior, became a widow at six. She was left in charge of her husband's brother, a Brahmin innkeeper in a country district, a day's journey by rail from Poona. As the child grew up, she became a regular little slave, beaten and half-starved. She was employed constantly in going backwards and forwards to a well a quarter of a mile away to fetch water, which she carried on her hips and her head in great copper vessels. She was very miserable and her treatment was no secret to the people around."

Writing about the woman of Indian, in the Missionary Review Julia R. Gibson says:—

"Infanticide is common in Indian, but girls are the chief victims. Among the Rajputs of Northern India some years ago in a community of 30,000 people there was not a single girl. This fact alone might help to elucidate the meaning of another rather pertinent saying: "The parents look after the boys and God looks after girls." Alas! Many of them are but the helpless victims of the old mid-wife's thumb on the exposed brain ere breath has been drawn. Some are drowned; some are left for the jackals; others are disposed of in various ways. If, perchance, they escape these methods, they are cruelly neglected until they die.

"What poison is that which appears like nectar?" "Woman."

"What is the chief gate of hell?" "Woman."
"What is cruel? The heart of a viper.
What is more cruel? The heart of a woman.
What is most cruel of all? The heart of a soulless, penniless widow."

Thus read some of the Hindu proverbs on woman. Is it possible to conceive anything

more heartless than the last quoted proverb—"the heart of a soulless, penniless widow?"

A similar sentiment was expressed by Buddha when he rejoiced that he had escaped the three curses of being born in hell, or as a vermin, or as a woman.

Dubois, an Indian Historian says:-

"Her husband may be crooked, aged, infirm, offensive in his manners let him; also be choleric and dissipated, irregular, a drunkard, a gambler, a debauchee; let him live in the world destitute of honour; let him be deaf or blind, his crimes and infirmities may weigh him down but never shall his wife regard him but as her god."

Mrs. W. S. Urquhart in "The Goal of India" says:—

It is doubtful if the sufferings of early motherhood, terrible as they are, can be compared with the life-long penance imposed upon child-widows. It is almost superfluous to do more than mention this subject, so often written about. It has recently given rise to agitations among Hindu reformers themselves. So painful is this topic in zenana that the name "widow" is scarcely ever spoken. One soon learns that it is considered unkind to say to a woman, "Are you a widow?" One finds out indirectly. "Since when has she been thus?" You may ask in a whisper of someone not too closely related. There is usually little need to ask. The marks of her forlorn state are plain to all. Grey-faced and meagre through much fasting, shaven and without ornament of any kind, dressed in a coarse and dingy sari and wearing withal the look of one inured to a colourless and joyless existence, she presents an appearance strikingly pathetic and mournful. Her signs of grief must be worn perpetually. To a woman with sons who has known and loved her husband, this life of penance may have some meaning and some solace; but what can it be for those who have no such compensating memory of joy?

The widow is to be regarded not only as afflicted but as accursed. Have not the gods given this signal punishment for the deeds done in a former existence? May she not fairly be counted as the cause of her husband's death and may not her advent be resented by his family? Her presence is regarded as an ill omen; therefore she is not allowed to appear at festive gatherings lest she should cast a

blight on the good fortune of others. It is easy to imagine the effect of such a position upon the mind of the widow, and to understand why, in the first hours of her bereavement, she screams and roars madly like a beast in pain, tearing her hair, casting off her garments, and sometimes passing through excess of emotion from one fit into another. Her behavior for a long period is like that of one demented: even suicide by self-starvation is sometimes attempted."

Statistics say that there are twenty six millions of widows in India. When we consider that many of these are under ten years of age and think of the lot of the Hindu widow, we may get a faint idea of the enormous amount of sorrow, shame and suffering which these figures reveal. We who have been brought up in Christian lands can never fully understand the shame and sorrow of the Hindu widow. We say shame; for to have to go with shaven head, and be considered the cause of her husband's death, and her very presence as causing harm, is enough to cause any one to want to slink out of sight and die. It is no wonder that many of these widows, even in childhood, loose all interest in life and waste away and die.

If any people of any land need Christ surely the women of this land do. Whether wives or widows, their lot is the lot of a woman in heathendom, that is to be despised and downtrodden and to be considered nothing much better than a beast of burden. Here is where the cow and the monkey are sacred and the woman despised, because they are without Christ. Christ and Christ alone can bring to them hope and joy for this life and the life to come.

If we could but comprehend a small part of their sufferings we would praise Christ for all he has saved us from, and with a heart of sympathy do what we can to bring them the same salvation which we enjoy.

"Millions are dying—
I can hear their bitter wail;
How dare I face them
If to help I fail!

#### SANCTIFICATION

Every device is being used to deceive the children of God, and if possible keep them from coming in to possession of their inheritance.

Anything to confuse and scatter the people is being taught, and as humanity is continually seeking an easy way, the easier is as continually being presented by perversion of the Scripture.

Though some advocates of the "second work" have brought it into disrepute by falseness in exposition of doctrine and failure to live the professed life, yet that two works are taught is plain according to the written Word.

"This is the will of God, even your sancitification." "You hath He quickened who were dead in trespasses and sins." There must be conception before birth. Jesus said: "Ye must be born again." If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." To forgive sins (actual transgressions) and to cleanse from all unrighteousness are not synonpmous. as shown by construction of sentence, and also by different meaning of words used.

Sins (actions) can be forgiven, but sin (the nature) cannot be forgiven, for its origin begins with the fall of man. David says, "shaped in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me." Yet there is a provision made for the removal of the law of sin, and the renewing of a right spirit within.

Paul speaks as a converted man (for the carnal mind is enmity against God) when he says, "with the mind, therefore, I serve God, yet I find a warring in my members, and when I would do good, evil is present with me."

In this condition he cried out, "O, wretched man that I am, who shall deliver me from the body of this death?" The answer is then given, "I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord."

"There is therefore now no comdemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus." (Rom. 8:1.) Christ in you the hope of glory" describes the justified experience, but to be in Christ means to be a partaker of His sufferings in sacrifice as a gift for service.

"Christ is not, as some teach, the altar, but He is the Gift upon the altar. A sinner cannot consecrate himself and become a part of the Gift "who is the Son consecrated forevermore," but a Christian or quickened soul can.

"God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life." He was the "Lamb slain from the foundation of the world." This was the general plan of God for the blotting out of sins, but "Christ so loved the Church that He gave Himself for it, that He might sanctify and cleanse it, that He might have a glorious church without spot or wrinkle."

"Christ, that He might sanctify His people, suffered without the gate." "Let us go forth therefore without the camp, bearing His reproach." Sanctification means to be cleansed and set apart for God. The sinner can only surrender, be pardoned and quickened into life by His spirit.

"Therefore, being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ." "By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God." Being justified, there is access by faith to another grace found through an act of consecration which brings us into Christ, where there is no condemnation because the law of disobedience is cleansed out, and the law of obedience found in Christ, operating, works "both to will and to do His good pleasure."

In the Old Testament times the high priest offered yearly sacrifices for the sin of the people and the daily sacrifies morning and evening. (Lev. 16:15; Heb. 10:3; Num. 28:3,4. Sanctification—Eph. 5:26; Heb. 10:10.)

Of what use were these types if there is only one work of grace? It is not necessary to wander in the wilderness forty years as did the Children of Israel before reaching Canaan; but the converted soul may step into the promised land as soon as the invitation is heard through the Spirit of God.

Though arrived at by a growth, sanctification is a crisis reached through consecration, which must come to every Christian living in obedience, though the experience is not always labeled, and many have lived and are living the consecrated life without knowledge of spiritual terms and phraseology.

This act, however, does not make the individual absolutely perfect as taught by some. The self-life still remains to "die daily," but as the consecration vow is kept fresh each day "by

walking in the light as He is in the light, the blood of Jesus Christ, His Son, cleanseth from all sin," and is a continual work under the law of obedience.

Sanctification, or the "new birth," is being put in the proper condition to grow.

The seed planted in the ground is quickened before it appears above the earth (when it becomes "first the blade, then the ear, then the full corn in the ear.") There is also the chicken life before the shell is broken, so is life in different phases.

Though justification or initial sanctification is necessary, the Christian life without consecration and the new birth, which delivers from the "body of death" (sin), Rom. 7:24), can never come to perfection any more than the seed under the ground or the unhatched chick can reach maturity.

This is, then, the perfection of which Paul speaks, (Phil. 3:15), "Let us therefore, as many as be perfect, be thus minded;" yet he plainly says he has not attained, neither is already perfect (verse 12), but "forgetting those things which are behind," he presses toward the mark for the prize of the high calling" of God in Christ Jesus. Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect."

"Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not appear what we shall be"—"But every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself even as He is pure."

The imputed righteousness received by the purified heart must be wrought out in the life by a sanctified walk; the law of disobedience is not only cleansed out but kept out because the law of obedience is operating through the consecrated life.

The work of our Christ for the full redemption of man was "finished" and "complete" when He died on the cross and rose triumphant over every foe, yet as He the Captain of our salvation, was made perfect through suffering, so those who would be like Him must step out the life He orders, faith making the Christ within a living power that really "changes from glory to glory," until again the "finished work" is revealed; for that which was made possible by His death has been attained by obedience to a living Christ, and the Sons of God are made manifest as the fullness of salvation appears through the "Adoption, to-wit, the redemption

of our bodies," and this mortal puts on immortality.

"And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly, and I pray God your whole spirit, soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. Faithful is He who has called you, who also will do it."
