Even if your child has an IEP, neuropsychological assessment, or other written description of her learning profile on file, teachers may not have a clear picture of who she is or what she actually needs at school. Parents are often the only ones with the "big picture" of a child's development...but this can be hard to articulate. It's also hard to find the time to write, and hard to keep emotions out of the communication process. This supportive workshop gives parents the structure they need to integrate and prioritize information about their kids, in a way that teachers can actually use. The resulting document can also be used to track goals and progress from year to year.
