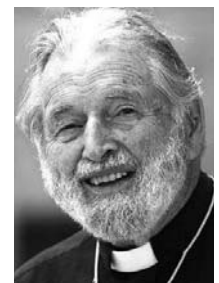

Broken relationships, sinful behaviors, unforgiven enemies, prejudices and hates, lukewarm faith, anguish and regrets, loneliness, ignorance, cowardice, and so many other human failings on our part and on the part of others are responsible for the knots in our lives.

The bondage of sin, and the realization that sins that may appear to be "freeing" actually bind and enslave us, is a traditional biblical image. Jesus, upon raising Lazarus from the dead, declared that his bonds should be loosed so he could be set free. Also traditional from the early Church is Mary's role as the great mediatrix, whose nimble fingers can undo the tangles of our sins in a heavenly intercession of maternal love.

The origin for the devotion to Mary, Undoer of Knots, is a meditation from Saint Irenaeus, Bishop of Lyon and a martyr of the early Church. In his book *Adversus Haereses* (Against Heresies), he builds upon Saint Paul's parallel between Adam and Christ, stating "Eve, by her disobedience, tied the knot of disgrace for the human race; whereas Mary, by Her obedience, undid it. For what the virgin Eve had bound fast through unbelief, this did the Virgin Mary set free through

faith."

The beautiful image of the Undoer or Untier of Knots, has been venerated in the pilgrim church of St. Peter in Perlack (Perlach), Bavaria, Germany, since 1700. Assisting Her at the task of straightening the cord of our life is an entire heavenly court of angels, signifying Her position as Queen of the Angels, and Queen of Heaven.

For three centuries, the devotion has survived among the faithful and appears to be growing, thanks to published booklets, websites such as: www.maryundoerofknots.com.

An official publication, containing the devotion's history, and a novena with nihil obstat and imprimatur, has been printed in 19 languages and distributed worldwide.

Part 35 CHAPTER THREE

THE PROCLAMATION OF THE GOSPEL

Person to person Continued

128. In this preaching, which is always respectful and gentle, the first step is personal dialogue, when the other person speaks and shares his or her joys, hopes and concerns for loved ones, or so many other heartfelt needs. Only afterwards is it possible to bring up God's word, perhaps by reading a Bible verse or relating a story, but always keeping in mind the fundamental message: the personal love of God who became man, who gave himself up for us, who is living and who offers us his salvation and his friendship. This message has to be shared humbly as a testimony on the part of one who is always willing to learn, in the awareness that the message is so rich and so deep that it always exceeds our grasp. At times the message can be presented directly, at times by way of a personal witness or gesture, or in a way which the Holy Spirit may suggest in that particular situation. If it seems prudent and if the circumstances are right, this fraternal and missionary encounter could end with a brief prayer related to the concerns which the person may

have expressed. In this way they will have an experience of being listened to and understood; they will know that their particular situation has been placed before God, and that God's word really speaks to their lives.

129. We should not think, however, that the Gospel message must always be communicated by fixed formulations learned by heart or by specific words which express an absolutely invariable content. This communication takes place in so many different ways that it would be impossible to describe or catalogue them all, and God's people, with all their many gestures and signs, are its collective subject. If the Gospel is embedded in a culture, the message is no longer transmitted solely from person to person. In countries where Christianity is a minority, then, along with encouraging each of the baptized to proclaim the Gospel, particular Churches should actively promote at least preliminary forms of inculturation. The ultimate aim should be that the Gospel, as preached in categories proper to each culture, will create a new synthesis with that particular culture. This is always a slow process and at we can be overly fearful. But if we allow doubts and fears to dampen our courage, instead of being creative we will remain comfortable and make no progress whatsoever. In this case we will not take an active part in historical processes, but become mere onlookers as the Church gradually stagnates.

Charisms at the service of a communion which evangelizes

130. The Holy Spirit also enriches the entire evangelizing Church with different charisms. These gifts are meant to renew and build up the Church. They are not an inheritance, safely secured and entrusted to a small group for safekeeping; rather they are gifts of the Spirit integrated into the body of the Church, drawn to the centre which is Christ and then channelled into an evangelizing impulse. A sure sign of the authenticity of a charism is its

ecclesial character, its ability to be integrated harmoniously into the life of God's holy and faithful people for the good of all. Something truly new brought about by the Spirit need not overshadow other gifts and spiritualities in making itself felt. To the extent that a charism is better directed to the heart of the Gospel, its exercise will be more ecclesial. It is in communion, even when this proves painful, that a charism is seen to be authentic and mysteriously fruitful. On the basis of her response to this challenge, the Church can be a model of peace in our world.

131. Differences between persons and communities can sometimes prove uncomfortable, but the Holy Spirit, who is the source of that diversity, can bring forth something good from all things and turn it into an attractive means of evangelization. Diversity must always be reconciled by the help of the Holy Spirit; he alone can raise up diversity, plurality and multiplicity while at the same time bringing about unity. When we, for our part, aspire to diversity, we become self-enclosed, exclusive and divisive; similarly, whenever we attempt to create unity on the basis of our human calculations, we end up imposing a monolithic uniformity. This is not helpful for the Church's mission.

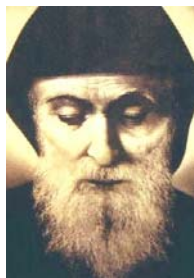
Culture, thought and education

132. Proclaiming the Gospel message to different cultures also involves proclaiming it to professional, scientific and academic circles. This means an encounter between faith, reason and the sciences with a view to developing new approaches and arguments on the issue of credibility, a creative apologetics which would encourage greater openness to the Gospel on the part of all. When certain categories of reason and the sciences are taken up into the proclamation of the message, these categories then become tools of evangelization; water is changed into wine. Whatever is taken up is not just redeemed, but becomes an instrument of the Spirit for enlightening and renewing the world.

- Part 13

Recent Documented Miracles

The testimonies contained in this article are miracles that were recently recorded at St. Maron's

Monastery in Annaya, Lebanon where St. Sharbel lived, died, and is buried. They were shared with those in attendance at the Healing Mass at St. A St. Agnes Catholic Church in Baton Rouge on October 22, 2018 by Fr. Charbel Jamboury.

The **first** testimony is from a fifty-two year old Canadian resident, Mrs. Yoland Ghantous, who had been diagnosed with breast cancer.

Mrs. Ghantous reported that she was fearful of a scheduled surgery and prayed to St. Sharbel beseeching his intercession. During the night, she saw a huge light in her room and reported seeing St. Sharbel coming to her and placing

his hands on her chest. The following night she dreamed of the Virgin Mary and also reported the smell of incense filling her home. On another night, she heard St. Sharbel tell her to anoint her breast with the holy oil from Annaya and not to be afraid. She was directed by St. Sharbel to go to Confession. She went to Confession and then went to Mass where she received Holy Communion. While praying after Communion, Mrs. Ghantous reported feeling a warm feeling on her chest. She returned to the doctor for an x-ray before the scheduled surgery, the new x-ray showed that the cancer was gone!

In thanksgiving, Mrs. Yoland Ghantous flew to Lebanon with her medical reports to register her miracle on September 23, 2018.

The **second** testimony is from Mrs. Salva Joseph Zakhyra, a sixty-seven year old mother from Australia.

Mrs. Zakhyra states that she was suffering from a progressive neck pain for over six months. She consulted her primary care physician who requested a CAT Scan and an MRI. The tests revealed a herniated disk and as a result was referred to a surgeon. Mrs. Zakhyra indicated that she was extremely afraid of any surgery and turned to St. Sharbel crying and praying faithfully

imploping his intercession for the grace of healing. During the night she dreamed of St. Sharbel who operated on her neck and St. Anthony the Great and St. Naemtallah who stood near St. Sharbel. When she awoke, she prayed to St. Sharbel and then proceeded to her scheduled MRI appointment that was set up by the surgeon. When the new MRI was compared to the old one, the surgeon exclaimed, "What did you do? There is no herniated disk in your neck. You are healed!"

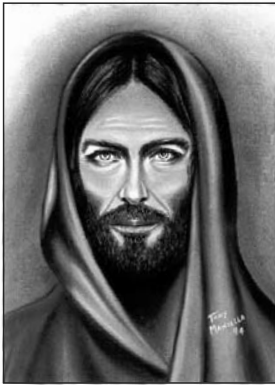
Mrs. Zakhyra made her first journey to Lebanon on October 13, 2018 to thank St. Sharbel for the gift of healing and to register her miracle.

The **third** and final testimony is from thirty-seven year old, Mrs. Maya Francis, a resident of Pennsylvania and mother of three.

Two years ago, Mrs. Francis was diagnosed with breast cancer and had undergone treatment. During her treatment she prayed to St. Sharbel asking his intercession for her healing. During that time she reports that she saw St. Sharbel in a dream in which he gave her incense and told her that she was healed. After a month and a half she started experiencing back pain that progressed to the point that she was admitted to

Healing Testimony

**Fr. Paul Bergeron's
story of his Healing of Cancer

The 12th - Margaret Trosclair, Marrero, LA

We pray the Rosary of the Seven Sorrows, called the Servite Rosary, every day at noon and at 3 p.m. We pray the "Divine Mercy Rosary" at Mary's Helpers.

Around the end of April, as we were praying at noon, I heard an inner voice say, "I want to be moved to the front." As you walk into the prayer feeling for a room Mother Mary's picture was to the right of the door. The next day during prayer I heard the inner voice say again, "Move me to the front." The third day, the same thing.

Walter came by and I told him we needed to move Mother Mary to the front of the chapel. He didn't ask any questions, he just said, "Okay." We moved the crown and veil to the left, we moved the bench to the right. We changed sides so the picture of Our Lady of Compassionate Protection - "Just Have Faith in My Son Jesus" could be where Mary wanted it to be. We then took down the large St. Michael picture that hung up in the peak of the chapel ceiling, where no one could see it, unless you walked into the chapel and turned around. Louis Saia gave Mary's Helpers this picture the first time he gave his testimony on our radio program, because he said he felt something here.

Walter hung St. Michael's picture where Mother Mary's was. After he left, I went back into our beautiful prayer room to see how it looked. Wow! It hit me like a ton of bricks. Of course she wanted to be moved there. Jesus is hanging on the Cross and "Our Sorrowful Mother" statue is at the foot of the cross, just where she belongs.

the hospital for medical tests. The tests revealed that her cancer had metastasized to her spine and two vertebrae in her neck were broken and required surgery. She was at risk for becoming paralyzed.

A cousin in Lebanon, learning of her situation, called her and asked her to join him in praying to St. Sharbel asking for his intercession. After this, she states that she saw St. Sharbel in her dream and he told her, "I am with you, don't do the surgery!" On October 9, 2018, the anniversary of St. Sharbel's canonization, Mrs. Francis arrived

in Lebanon and with her family and relatives proceeded directly to the monastery of St. Maron. The group arrived at the monastery at 11:30 p.m. and found it closed. She asked her family to help her sit in front of the statue of St. Sharbel. Her cousin, who was in the group, telephoned the Superior of the monastery and explained the situation to him. The Superior met with Mrs. Francis and gave her the blessing and holy oil from St. Sharbel. Mrs. Francis saw St. Sharbel and was able to move without her wheelchair and also was able to move her neck and limbs.

On the other side of the St. Joseph table is a 5 foot statue of St. Joseph holding Baby Jesus. Since we are promoting the St. Joseph table to bring families back together, Mother Mary wanted to be next to her spouse St. Joseph and Her Son Baby Jesus, as a family.

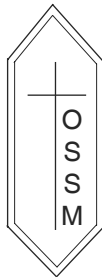
