FEDERAL ISSUES


- > OBAMACARE Repeal & replace with patient centered solutions
- > IMMIGRATION Enforce existing law, control borders & stop benefits to illegals
- > TAX POLICY Incentivize investment & fair trade, cut individual rates & drop loopholes
- > DEBT Cut budget via hiring freezes, line item veto & sustainable entitlement reform
- > REGULATION Ax Dodd-Frank, rein in EPA, red-line w/Congressional & 10th Amend, filters
- > MILITARY Rebuild capability, readiness & technology advantage; support veterans
- > TERRORISM Fight on all fronts , use Guantanamo & stop importing potential radicals
- > EDUCATION Better lives via high standards, staff accountability, more state control & school choice
- > CONGRESS Efficiency via regular order budgeting & Senate filibuster rules changes
