FEDERAL ISSUES


- > OBAMACARE - Repeal & replace with patient centered solutions
- > IMMIGRATION - Enforce existing law, control borders & stop benefits to illegals
- > TAX POLICY - Incentivize investment & fair trade, cut individual rates & drop loopholes
- > DEBT - Cut budget via hiring freezes, line item veto & sustainable entitlement reform
- > REGULATION - Ax Dodd-Frank, rein in EPA, red-line w/Congressional & 10th Amend. filters
- > MILITARY - Rebuild capability, readiness & technology advantage; support veterans
- > TERRORISM - Fight on all fronts , use Guantanamo & stop importing potential radicals
- > EDUCATION - Better lives via high standards, staff accountability, more state control & school choice
- > CONGRESS - Efficiency via regular order budgeting & Senate filibuster rules changes
- > ENERGY- Independence by axing subsidies , specious climate deals & new source barriers

STATE ISSUES

- > GROWTH - Manufacturing rebound via tax policy, infrastructure & workforce skills
- > EDUCATION - Strengthen school choice, drop common core, cut DPI/BOE bureaucracy
- > ELECTIONS - Voter confidence/integrity via tighter registration, voter ID & clear, partisan ballot
- > FINANCE - Close unfunded pension gap, sustain rainy day fund, cut state income taxes
- > ILLEGALS - Require e-verify, eliminate sanctuary cities & stop benefits
- > MEDICAID - Control eligibility & services to serve only those in true need
- > SAFETY - Firm commitment to law and order & policing; resources for mental health
