

# FAQ

## Advanced Placement License Practical Nursing

Q. When is open enrollment and when is the start date?

A. *We accept applications from April 1<sup>st</sup> to June 1<sup>st</sup>. The start date is in the fall semester, August.*

Q. *What courses are required to be accepted into Advanced Placement?*

A. *You must have a minimum of 25 earned college credits, in addition to College Algebra, Anatomy and Physiology I & II. These courses had to be taken within 5 years and you must have a "B" or better in order to get credit.*

Q. What is considered a complete packet?

A. *A complete packet includes the required documents: application, college transcripts within the last 5 years, current CNA certification, Wonderlic and Accuplacer scores, official High School /official GED Score, immunization records, and job reference letters.*

Q. How long is the course?

A. *The course starts in the fall (August) and ends the following year in the summer, June.*

Q. Is financial aid available?

A. *Yes, financial aid is available and you may obtain information from the Student Services Department.*

Q. How many people are accepted into the program?

A. *The program availability varies because it is based on how many students drop out of the program. Past year placements range from 3-7 seats.*

Q. How is the selection for each class determined?

A. *The selection process is based on a scoring system, which includes providing reference letters, scoring from the Accuplacer and Wonderlic tests, and having pre-requisite courses that may transfer. The courses had to be taken within the last 5 years with a grade of "B" or better in order to receive the transfer credit.*

Q. When and where is the Accuplacer and Wonderlic test given?

A. *Both tests are administered in the Financial Aid office. The cost of the Accuplacer test is \$10 and \$15 for the Wonderlic test. No appointment is needed, but it is given on a first come first serve basis. You may test M-F from 730 a.m. to 12 p.m. The Accuplacer is good up to 3 years and can be retaken 14 days later, but you will have to pay another fee. A photo I.D. is required.*

Q. *How will I know if I am accepted into the program that I chose?*

A. *You will be notified by mail, phone or email.*

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
