## Who operates OSHC services?

OSHC is delivered by providers who have been approved by the Regulatory Authority. Our service is overseen by parents in our school. We are a *NOT FOR PROFIT* service operated by a specifically formed parent-run management committee.

## What is the role of an Educator?

Educators provide a fun and safe program and environment, designed to meet your children's needs and interests. Our Educational Leader, Wendy Keighran, leads our team of Educators.

The person overseeing the daily operations of the service is known as the Nominated Supervisor, Coordinator or Director.

Our service is led by our Director, Sonja de Jong, she is assisted by Shona Brighton, Assistant Director.

A nominated 'responsible person' is present at all times to ensure the safety and well-being of all children who are in attendance.

## How much does OSHC cost?

OSHC services typically offer two types of bookings, permanent and casual care, fees will vary for these booking types.

The Commonwealth Government provides assistance through the Child Care Subsidy to reduce the fees associated with child care, Families can use the [Child Care Subsidy Calculator](#) for an estimate of the rebate they will receive.
