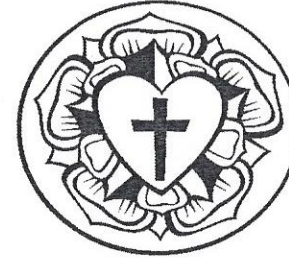


Calling all graduates!!!

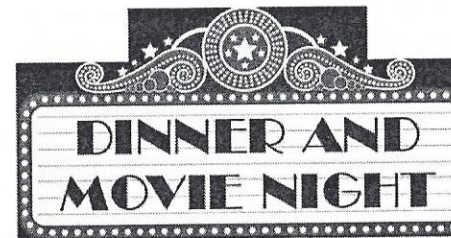

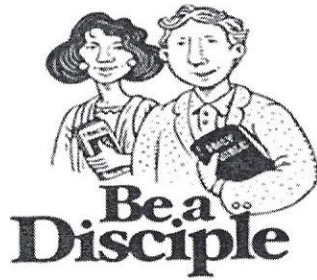
MY FATHER'S HOUSE

It's been a long time since we have had a full-time pastor. The call committee has been doing everything to find one. But you know we as a congregation can

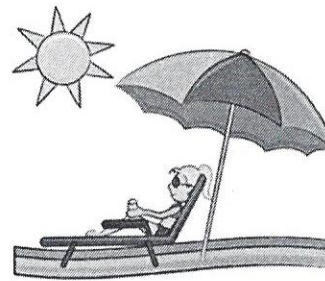
