<u>Days</u>" form to Dr. Natali's office. The rate is \$99.28 per day. Please be aware that you can accumulate up to 200 days in your sick day bank. Any days in excess of 200 should be sold back to the district or donated to the Sick Bank.

#### H. Eyeglass Reimbursement- Reminder

We are in year one of a two-year cycle for eyeglass/contact purchases. Members have \$400 to spend on glasses/contacts. Such coverage may be used for the members and their family. Completed claim forms with receipts attached must be sent to the HR department in Administration.

### I. Study Money Dates

Those who applied for the May 12th summer study money will be notified shortly of their approval status. Looking ahead to next year the tuition reimbursement dates will be Fall- 9/29/23, Winter-12/8/23, and Summer-5/10/24. The application is available online at <u>Request for Participation in Study Program— Group A</u>.

#### J. Pay Options

Each year you have three pay options:

- 21 equal bi-weekly payments (September through June)
- 25 payments; 21 payments (September through June) + 4 payments on the last day of school
- 26 payments; you will receive 1/26 of your annual salary every two weeks from the first pay date in September through the last pay date in June when you will receive the remaining paychecks as separate checks, all dated June 30, which you may deposit at any time from June to August. Direct deposit will not be available for the last six paychecks. All deductions will be spread out over the 26 paychecks.

To elect an option other than the one you currently have, you must enroll prior to June 30 and the new option may not be changed until the start of the following school year. The new form will be available soon.

#### K. Packing and Unpacking

Teachers who are moving and/or packing due to an alternative use of their room or a room transfer shall be paid \$26.49 per hour, up to a maximum of 4 hours. The work must be done outside of the school day and a record kept of the dates and times.


