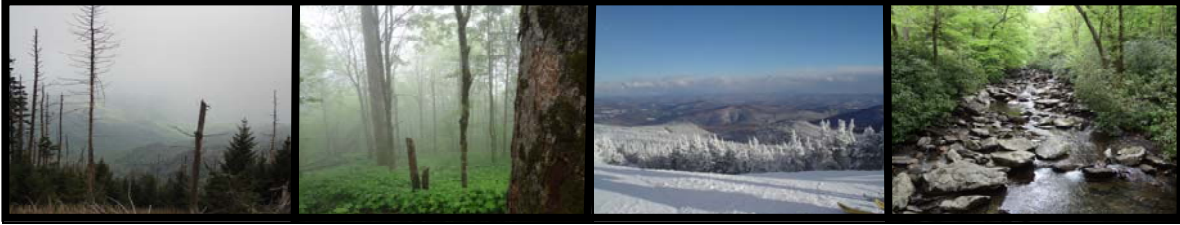

ACRE-FOR-ACRE Program

For every acre of disturbance in which Pinewoods Engineering prepares a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan; we will support the conservation of an equal amount of acreage in a critical ecological area*

This program is intended to support and encourage a balanced approach to; development done with environmental integrity, and conservation of valuable and significant ecological areas.

- Eligibility:
- (a) New signed contracts for the preparation of a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan and new Notice of Intent, for the purposes of obtaining coverage under the New York State Construction General Stormwater Discharge Permit (GP-0-15-002).
 - (b) With a minimum contract amount of \$1,000.00. Maximum contribution per contract is \$500.00 or 2% of the original contract amount, whichever is less.

The Acre-For-Acre Program is a symbolic gift to support the general mission of conservation of critical ecological areas

*Subject to the Terms and Conditions of the Acre-For-Acre Program. Pinewoods Engineering ("PWEng") will contribute funds to a 501(C)(3) non-profit nature conservation organization ("charity") in an amount approximately equal to the whole acreage (part-there-of excluded) as denoted on the Notice of Intent submitted to the State. An Acre-for-Acre contribution is interpreted as a contribution of \$25 per whole acre of disturbance up to the \$500 or 2% of the contract amount, whichever is less. Clients are not responsible for any reimbursement should the terms of the promotion be found to be void after the contribution is made. This program is done purely at the voluntarily and sole discretion of PWEng. PWEng retains the rights to modify, interpret, substitute, exclude or terminate this program as we see fit. The donation is not transferable, exchangeable or payable in cash or other products or services.
