No Arrivals Before noon on Thursday, May 2 without prior notice Stalls must be vacated by 9:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 5

If you are arriving before Thursday, please notify show management in advance so that we can be sure your stalls are ready for you.

All participating horses must be AMHA registered. All horses must be measured or present a valid measurement card issued by AMHA. Stalls are \$90.00 for the weekend. Camper hook-ups are \$40.00 per night. Valid AMHA registration, certification of veterinary inspection on stallions 3 & older, coggins (current within 1 year), health certificate within 45 days on out-of-state horses, youth and/or amateur numbers must be provided. General Rules and Information:

This show is accredited and conducted under the 2024 rules and regulations of the AMHA. All horses must be registered with the AMHA.

This AMHA show has three judges. Points and awards will be awarded by each judge.

Awards will be given to 1st - 6th place. Championship ribbons will be awarded to Grand Champions.

Welcome to the Somervell Expo Center!

Stabling: Stalls are 10' x 10' with metal construction on concrete floors. No more than 2 horses per stall. Stallions 2

& older must be stalled separately **NO BEDDING IS INCLUDED WITH THE STALLS & NO OUTSIDE BEDDING MAY BE BROUGHT ONTO THE SHOW GROUNDS**. Shavings are available for \$10.00. Showing off the trailer is permitted at a cost of \$30.00/horse. Please help keep the

facility clean by putting trash in the barrels and manure in the dumpsters.

Early Arrivals: Exhibitors wishing to arrive before noon on Thursday 5/2 or layover on Sunday, 5/5 must make advance

arrangements with Show Management and will be charged an additional \$25 per stall per night.

<u>Camping</u>: Full hookups with water and electric are \$40.00 per night. Payment is available on the entry forms.

<u>Food Stand</u>: A concession stand will be in operation Friday - Sunday during show hours.

Smoking: No smoking will be allowed in the barns, on deck, in the arena or in the horse show office.

<u>Dogs</u>: Dogs must be leashed or penned at all times and are NOT allowed in the concession area.

Somervell Expo Center is located northeast of Glen Rose on Highway 67 (also known as Big Bend Trail). The Expo Center is on the north and may be entered off Bo Gibbs Blvd. which runs along the

west side of the Expo Center.

Exhibitors: arrangements can be made, if necessary. Please contact the show manager.

Measurement: All horses must be measured before entering the show ring. Horses will be measured in accordance

with AMHA rules beginning on Thursday, May 2 from 2:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. and resuming Friday and Saturday mornings at 7:00 a.m. Hardship measurements will be done during regular scheduled measuring

times and/or immediately following the last class of the show day.

Paperwork Copies of registration papers must be included with entries. Entries submitted without registration papers will be held pending receipt of same. Gelding status must be reflected on the registration papers.

Each horse must have a current coggins. Out-of-state should bring original negative coggins report

(within one year) and health within 45 days.

Youth Classes: All youth must have an AMHA Youth number. Youth card applications are available at the Horse Show

Office. Youth membership fee is a one-time fee of \$20.00 or \$25.00 if applied for at show.

An AMHA Amateur Card is required to participate in Amateur classes. Amateur cards are **Amateur** \$20.00 or \$25.00 if applied for at show. Applications are available from the Show Manager. **Classes**:

There will be NO harnessing or hitching of miniatures in the main aisle from the warm-up arena to the Driving **Exhibitors**: Show Arena. Please harness in the side aisles and hitch up out in the warm-up arena. This is for safety and liability concerns. Thank you.

Evaluation Forms:

Judge and Steward evaluation forms will be available at the horse show office.

Liability Statement: Southwestern Miniature Horse Club, its officers, officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, driver, groom, attendant or other employee, animal or equipment at this show. THIS SHALL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY to this show or show grounds.

Show Policy:

Evidence of any cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment to a horse, in or out of the ring, will not be tolerated by the Show Management and shall result in disqualification of the horse and that exhibitor for the balance of the show. The offender will be barred from the show area for the duration of the show. The results shall be the forfeiture of all trophies, ribbons, awards, and points for that show. The show manager will notify AMHA of any such disqualification when the show results are reported.

Pre-Entries: Pre-Entries must be postmarked by April 6, 2024.

Added Classes: Added classes will be accepted up to four classes preceding the class to be entered.

Refunds: The SWMHC will give a full refund if entries are cancelled in writing by the pre-entry closing date. If entries are cancelled in writing to the show manager and accompanied by a veterinarian's or doctor's certificate of inability to show after the pre-entry closing date, but before the official start of the show (8:00 a.m. Friday, May 3) all fees other than the stall and office fee will be refunded. After the official

start of the show, there will be no refunds. Substitutions will be accepted without penalty.

The fee for commercial exhibitors is per day depending on the size of the booth and use of electricity. **Vendors:** Tables and chairs are not provided. Contact Show Management for a contract. Rates are as follows:

> \$25 per day - 10 x 10 display or tent with no electricity \$35 per day - 10 x 10 display or tent with electricity \$50 per day - 10 x 20 trailer with electricity \$75 per day - 10 x 40 trailer with electricity
