According to the Missouri Department of Social Services, in Fiscal Year 2017 there were 1,132 substantiated incidents of child sexual abuse in Missouri involving 1,261 children, 214 of whom were in the counties of our diocese. You can help prevent this from happening and ensure that our parishes, schools and homes are safe places fore all children. The diocese of Jefferson City will hold a VIRTUS protecting God's Children on Wednesday, August 22, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. at Immaculate Conception School, Montgomery City. Class will be held in the school cafeteria. Participants should register in advance at www.virtus.org. Please arrive early so that the class may begin on time. Due to the nature of the subject, children are dis-

couraged from attending.

### **High School Religious Education & Confirmation Classes**


