





**NCM Sinkhole update**: The sinkhole-damaged 1962 Corvette has now been restored as good as new by National Corvette Museum crews. The Tuxedo Black roadster was one of the eight classic Corvettes that plunged into the sinkhole that suddenly opened up underneath the NCM on Feb. 12, 2014. The '62 had been donated to the Museum in 2011.

During the past year, members of the NCM team have been busy repairing the damage done by the fall into the sinkhole. The car will be put back into its original pre-sinkhole display space in the Skydome. GM donated \$25,000 to cover the restoration.

The 2009 Blue Devil ZR1 and the 1992 1 Millionth Corvette damaged by the sinkhole have previously been restored. The other five 'Vettes that plunged into the hole will continue to be displayed in their *as-found* condition and will not be restored.

In February 2017, the car was removed from its display in the Skydome still wearing all of the dirt and dust from its subterranean adventure.

It was transferred to an NCM garage bay for repairs. Given that the work was performed in the Museum, visitors have been able to watch the



progress as

it was actually happening and see the car come back to life.





In 2018, Corvette Racing celebrates its 20<sup>th</sup> season of competition. They have enjoyed considerable success at several venues but at Sebring International Raceway in Florida, where the upcoming 12-hour endurance race will run, the team has claimed class victories 11 times since its first win in 2002, when Ron Fellows, Johnny O'Connell and current driver Oliver Gavin took the GTS win. Next month on the March 16-18 weekend, Corvette Racing will be seeking its fourth consecutive Sebring GTLM victory.

"Sebring certainly holds a lot of great memories for Corvette Racing, some very interesting memories, some not so interesting," said Corvette Racing Program Manager Doug Fehan. "Early on when we started here, this was our Bermuda Triangle. Back in 1999 and 2000, we couldn't do anything right here. No matter what we did, it turned out to be disastrous. But as usual, we kept our shoulder to the wheel, heads down and have developed a pretty good relationship with the track right now."

Doug went on to say "The cars like it here...the drivers like the track because it's fast. It takes a great deal of skill and experience to be able to run the full 12 hours without hitting anything, without breaking anything and without running off the racetrack. You need to be prepared for this event and this event alone. Don't. Lose. Focus. This racetrack is so unique in so many ways."

Corvette Racing will aim for another class win with Jan Magnussen, Antonio Garcia & Mike Rockenfeller in the No. 3 Corvette







and with Oliver Gavin, Tommy Milner & Marcel Fassler (below) in the No. 4 car.




