



Butter cookies



Materials needed:

Wooden spoon
Big bowl
Cookie cutters
A cup

Ingredients:

2 eggs
2 ½ cups of flour
Vanilla essence
1 teaspoon of baking powder
100 grams of butter
A cup of sugar

Directions:

1. In a bowl, mix the butter and the sugar
2. Add the eggs and the vanilla essence
3. Add the flour and the baking powder
4. Make a ball and leave it in the fridge for 1 hour
5. Preheat the oven 170°C
6. Roll out the dough. Use a cookie cutter to make the shape
7. Bake them for 10-15 minutes
8. Let them cool down






