- Daniel Fast Monday, Tues & Wed
- Two Day Absolutely Nothing Fast Beginning 5 AM Thursday – 5 AM Saturday
- Daniel fast Saturday morning beginning 5 AM to 5 PM Sunday (which will end the fast and the Solemn Assembly)

# Devotions

*January 18 – January 24*

## **Day 8 - Take smart risks**

**Scripture for Meditation: - Luke 14:28**

### **Prayer:**

- 1. Smart risk-taking involves passion, planning, active learning, communication, and the ability to embrace and reward the inevitable small failures along the way.*
- 2. May we count up the cost recognizing and agreeing to the terms of discipleship. The terms of discipleship require us to give ourselves totally to Jesus, letting go of our personal desires and proclivities.*
- 3. May we be willing to answer the call to shift.*
- 4. May our personal witness be effective as we stand steadfast in our faith and surrender to God no matter the cost, understanding that cost may include loss of friends, family, popularity and other worldly gain.*
- 5. May we possess the spiritual insight of when to begin and when to end. Lord, give to us a keen sense of timing. Give us courage to activate ideas and innovations that we were too apprehensive to embrace before. Teach us how not to over-analyze before going forward with the plan.*

# Day 9 - Maximize the benefits of mentorship.

*“Iron sharpens iron” ~BCST*

**Scripture for meditation: Proverbs 27:17**

## **Prayer:**

1. May we be sharpened by interaction with another through fellowship; not allowing isolation from fellow believers to limit our spiritual growth.
2. May we always feel encouraged and supported as we journey through life. May we learn from the experiences and mistakes of others
3. May our social and academic confidence be developed, our communications and personal skills be increased, and may we become more empowered to make right decisions.
4. May we gain valuable insight into the next stages of our life. Cause us to identify goals and establish a sense of direction.
5. May multiple doors of opportunity open according to God's will, purpose, and timing.

# Day 10 - Know when to say NO.

“Saying yes to the right things begins with saying no to the wrong things” ~BCST

**Scripture for meditation:** Matthew 5:37

## Prayer:

1. May we learn to set definite boundaries. A boundary is the line between what is OK and what is not OK. Teach us how to set physical, emotional, and mental boundaries.
2. May we always be careful not to commit to do something when we are fully aware it will not be possible to fulfill that commitment. It is scripturally correct to keep the vows we make to God and others.
3. May we recognize and understand that if we say “Yes” we must fully intend to make it good. It is better to say “No” than to contrive a way to avoid accountability. This is paramount to lying.
4. May we always give ourselves permission to stay within our self-defined limits.
5. May we find ourselves always being honest with ourselves first and with others.

# Day 11 - Know thyself

**Scripture for meditation:** 2 Corinthians 13:5

## Prayer:

1. May we daily self-examine in light of the Scriptures in order to keep us humble and honest.
2. May we not be defined by our culture, our societal labels, or our present economic status. Teach us to walk in Your image and after Your likeness.
3. May we identify our weaknesses and our strengths in the natural and in the spiritual and find ways to cause them to work in our favor. May we not remain wounded by life's events because "hurting people hurt people."
4. Teach us how to "be still" and realize "who" we really are! Let us not run from "quiet times". May we find our passion and mission in life in stillness.
5. May we see ourselves as God sees us and seek to become that person. Cause us not to live in the opinion or verdict of other but rather cause us to see and know our "worth" and walk therein.



# Day 12 - Choose your friends wisely

**Scripture for meditation:** Proverbs 12:26

## Prayer:

1. The Bible says, "A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for a time of adversity." "My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends."
2. Teach me Lord how to:
  - a. Choose friends with like Godly values.
  - b. Choose friends with common goals.
  - c. Choose friends who can bring balance in areas where I am weaker.
  - d. Choose friends that stretch, motivate and encourage me.
  - e. Choose friends that are worthy of my trust.
  - f. Choose friends that have a thirst for knowledge and a desire to grow.
3. May I always remember that "Corrupt communication breeds bad manners." May I always be able to distinguish between true friends, acquaintances, and hanger on-ers.
4. May I never act outside of character or beliefs to retain a friendship.
5. May there always be a respect for set boundaries.
6. May I always acknowledge that Jesus is my Friend, for Proverbs 18:24 says, A man that hath friends must shew himself friendly: and there is a friend that sticketh closer than a brother.

# Day 13 - The Reality of the Supernatural

**Scripture for meditation:** Isaiah 40:28

## Prayer:

1. May I learn to walk daily in the reality of the supernatural as a vessel for miracles, signs, and wonders.
2. May I have a deeper intimacy with You God and experience the reality of the supernatural. I welcome the encounter of knowing You as a bigger God than I have ever known before!
3. May I develop the mindset of the Kingdom of God. Guide me as I explore the realm of the supernatural and the agenda of heaven.
4. Teach me how to live and operate in alignment with the supernatural ways of God.
5. Speak to me, Lord!

# Day 14 - Possessing the Supernatural

“If at first you don’t succeed try another way!”

**Scripture for meditation:** Acts 19:2

## Prayer:

1. Lord, FILL ME over and over again with the supernatural power of the Holy Spirit! I receive YOUR spirit to operate freely in my life that I may know you and supernaturally participate with you to do great exploits on the earth!
2. Pour out the Holy Spirit on all those who desire to receive you. Thank you that our families, cities, and nation, and world will be filled with the Holy Spirit.
3. May I always be aware of the power I possess in the Holy Spirit! Let me always remember that the same power that raised Jesus from the dead dwells in ME now!
4. Teach me more about the power that I possess in the Holy Ghost so I may demonstrate the same power and disciple others to know, love, obey, and follow you.
