Outreach to El Salvador Police

Dear Friend,

The Lord allowed me to travel to El Salvador with Jeff Sill and Mark Werts to minister to the police. We partnered with missionary, Kenton Moody, who opened up his church for us to do training for the police. The church fed and gave a Bible to each police officer who attended.

We had a different group of police officers from the city of Santa Ana each day. We trained a total of 325 officers during the week we were there. Each day I presented the gospel and we saw 131 officers pray to receive Christ as their Savior with us.

Pastor Kenton invited officers forward at the end of each day who wanted prayer. We saw over 100 officers come forward during the week. I saw many of them weeping as we prayed for them and ministered to them.

I have seldom seen a group of veteran police officers more attentive to the training and the gospel. We were told that in this city of over 400,000 there were 77 police officers killed in the line of duty last year. Everyone of these officers has had friends and co-workers killed in the line of duty.

El Salvador is one of the most violent places in the world and has one of the highest homicide rates per capita in the world. They have over 70,000 gang members in the country. The MS-13 gang is one of the most violent. In this context the ministry to the police is very important.

Mark Werts who is a police officer and paramedic raised money to buy 150 tourniquets which he took with him to El Salvador. He taught the police how to use them and they will be distributed among the police in that part of El Salvador as well as other places in the country.
