Ill. Steven George Miller, 33° July 19, 1961 – May 11, 2017

Ill. Brother Steve Miller passed away unexpectedly on May 11, 2017. During the past year Steve was undergoing dialysis for kidney failure while also trying to recuperate from heart by-pass surgery at the same time. A combination of factors proved too much for his body to handle.

Steve joined the Scottish Rite in October 1982. He received his 32° KCCH on November 21, 2005 and was Coroneted a 33° IGH on September 7, 2013 by the Valley of Las Cruces, Orient of New Mexico. Steve served as head of all 4 bodies in the El Paso Scottish Rite and participated as a Degree Team member and as a Degree Master in many Reunions.

In addition to his Scottish Rite activity, Steve was Past Potentate of El Maida Shrine and was a long time member of the Drum and Bugle Corps and the Red Barons. He was a Past Master of Fraternity Lodge No. 1111, El Paso Lodge No. 130 and Five Points Lodge No. 1137 and served as District Deputy Grand Master of Masonic District Number 60A.

Ill. Lloyd D. Muir, 33° June 15, 1933 – August 13, 2017

Ill. Brother Lloyd D. Muir passed away peacefully at home on August 13, 2017. Bro. Lloyd will be long remembered for his dedication to the Masonic Fraternity. Lloyd joined the Scottish Rite in October 1966. He received his 32° KCCH Honor on October 4, 1999 and was Coroneted a 33° IGH on November 14, 2009.

Lloyd was a 50-year Member of the Scottish Rite and served as Wardrobe Chairman for the Scottish Rite Reunions for many years. He was an integral part of every successful Reunion. Lloyd served as Wise Master, Commander and Master of Kadosh of the Scottish Rite Bodies.

In addition to his Scottish Rite activities, Lloyd was Past Potentate of El Maida Shrine and was a past Director of the Royal Order of Jesters and member of the Red Barons. He was a Past Master of El Paso Lodge No. 130 and was instrumental in the maintenance and upkeep of the Masonic Cemetery.
