

## LIGHT HORSE AND SADDLE PONY RULES

(All rules are subject to change at the discretion of the Light Horse Committee)

1	Invite entry forms will be mailed to people living in Queens, Kings, Sunbury, Saint John, and York Counties in New Brunswick. The Light Horse Committee reserves the right to "special invite" from any area.
2	No entry fee per class.
3	Limited to 38 stalls
4	Light horse/pony is less than 1300 lbs;
5	Youth Division (up to and including 16 years of age) has two groups: 1. ponies 11.2 & under ( <u>riders must be 12 years and under</u> ) 2. Ponies over 11.2 and horses, ( <u>this group will be done by age of rider at the discretion of the Light Horse Committee</u> ).
6	Horses used to compete in one division cannot be used in another division (i.e. horses used in Youth Division cannot be used in horse classes).
7	Any horse or pony used for Tiny Tot Class will need a waiver signed.
8	No one can compete in any class without a signed wavier. Exhibitors are responsible for anyone riding their horses outside of competition, this includes sitting on, walking, etc...
9	Stalls will be assigned.
10	Ribbons will be awarded for all classes in placing of 1 <sup>st</sup> through 5 <sup>th</sup> .
11	Prize money of \$40 will be allotted to exhibitor if they have shown in line classes plus half of the allotted classes; which means half of the classes in each of Section 5, 5A, and 7 for light horse and half the classes in each of Sections 5A, 6 and 7 for saddle pony.
12	Any light horse or pony brought strictly for games or strictly for performance classes will receive \$20.
13	Prize money will be allotted at the discretion of the Light Horse Committee.
14	Numbers will be assigned to exhibitor.
15	Numbers are to be turned in before cheques are picked up on Sunday.
16	No stallions are permitted to show in light horse or pony divisions regardless of age either handler or animal.
17	At any time on the fairgrounds <u>anyone under 18 must wear a helmet while mounted.</u>
18	Helmets will be allowed as proper attire in English and Western classes.

19	Light horse and pony exhibitors will use assigned gate for entry to classes.
20	Handlers, <u>must be 18 years</u> and over and will not be permitted in any class other than Tiny Tots and Costume Class.
21	All Light horses must remain on the grounds until 5:00 p.m. on Sunday and can be picked up between 5:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.
22	Pony rides are <u>not</u> permitted. See Rule 32 in Rules and Regulations.

**SECTION 5 – LIGHT HORSES - ADULT**  
(Light Horse, under 1,300 lbs)

Class	
1.	Western Pleasure – Western saddle and equipment to be used. Riders to be dressed in Western attire and only one hand on reins. To be shown at a flat-footed walk, trot, lope and hand gallop both ways of the ring on a reasonable loose rein and on the correct lead at all times. Must stand quietly when rider dismounts and mounts, back readily. To be judged on performance, manners, conformation and appointments.
2.	Scutta Ho – pattern to be posted day of show.
3.	Parade – to be shown with stock saddle or other colourful equipment. To be shown at walk and parade gait. Appointments 25%; performance, animation, manners and conformation 75%.
4.	Game - to be announced at time of event.
5.	Trail Class – open to English or Western. Course to be posted day of show
6.	Command Class

**SECTION 5A – LIGHT HORSES & SADDLE PONIES**  
(Light Horse, under 1,300 lbs)

1.	Pole Bending – Adult	6.	Relay Race – Youth

**SECTION 6 – YOUTH**  
(Light Horse, under 1,300 lbs)

Class	
1.	Mare or gelding 2 years and over, to be shown on line – 11.2 & under hands.
2.	Mare or gelding 2 years and over, to be shown on line – Over 11. 2 hands.
3.	Western Pleasure – to be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. To be judged on manners and performance.
4.	Parade for both Youth groups – to be shown with stock saddle or other colourful equipment. To be shown at walk and parade gait. To be judged on appearance and performance.
5.	Command Class
6.	Games to be announced at time of event.
7.	Trail Class – course to be posted on the day of show.
8.	Scutta Ho – pattern to be posted on the day of show.

**SECTION 7 – MISCELLANEOUS CLASS**  
(Light Horse, under 1,300 lbs, Youth Division (Horses and Ponies))

Class	
1.	Pairs Class - Adult - Western or English attire. To be shown at a walk, trot or jog, and canter or lope both ways of the ring. To be judged on performance suitability as a pair, quality and manners.
2.	Pairs Class - Youth - Western or English attire. To be shown at a walk, trot or jog, canter or lope both ways of the ring. To be judged on performance, suitability as a pair, quality and manners.
3.	Costumes - Youth judged on suitability, costume and manners.
4.	Costumes - Adult judged on suitability, costume and manners.
5.	Family Class - open to Adult or Youth. Judged on performance as a family, quality and manners. Open to two or more members of the same family.

6.	Tiny Tot – open to horses or ponies. May not enter any other classes except for Costume (rider must be between 1 & 8 years of age).
7.	Showmanship Exhibitor Youth - to be judged on exhibitor's performance.
8.	Showmanship Exhibitor Adult - to be judged on exhibitor's performance.
9.	Equitation Exhibitor Youth – Western or English attire. To be judged on rider's performance.
10.	Equitation Exhibitor Adult – Western or English attire. To be judged on rider's performance.
