Congress passed a resolution in 1926 for an annual observance, and Nov. 11 became a national holiday beginning in 1938. In 1954, President Eisenhower officially changed the name of the holiday from Armistice Day to Veterans Day. Veterans Day is not to be confused with

Memorial Day— Memorial Day (the fourth Monday in May) honors American service members who died in service to their country or as a result of injuries incurred during battle. Veterans Day pays tribute to all American veterans—living or dead, especially living veterans who served their country honorably during war or peacetime.

In Europe, Britain and the Commonwealth countries it is common to observe two minutes of silence at 11 a.m.

Post American Legion Expense Process

Operating procedures for members attending American Legion Meetings & Functions.

- 1. American Legion Breakfasts and Dinners The member must also be in good standing and must attend at least four meetings in a calendar year. The member must pay the **full price** of the ticket and at the meeting before the event. He or she will be reimbursed for half **the ticket price** at the meeting following the event.
- 2. Conventions Members who would like to attend American Legion Conventions and Conferences will be reimbursed for half of the cost of the hotel in a shared room and will be able to receive \$50 towards gas and tolls. They must attend at least six meetings in a calendar year. These funds will also be given to the members at the meeting following the event.
- 3. Any motions for donations that are brought up on the floor during a meeting that amount to more than \$100 will only be voted on by the board of directors unless a fund raiser is held to pay for a specific event.
- 4. The Post Commander will receive a \$30.00 allowance each month for expenses.
- 5. Members of the Post can make a motion during new business for the Post to make a minimal donation to needed organizations with a maximum of \$100 except for Religious and Political Groups.
- 6. The Post will send flowers in the event of the passing away of a member, their spouse or their children.
