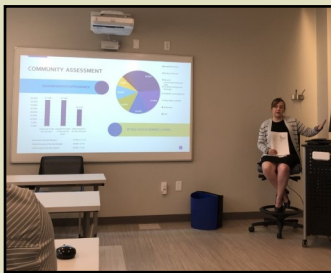


City reveals strategic plan

BEDFORD — The City of Bedford, with the assistance of consulting firm Lochmueller Group, has completed the process of creating Bedford's comprehensive plan designed to guide city leaders for the next 20 years. The initial draft of the recently completed plan represents community residents' concerns and wishes gleaned from months of face-to-face and online surveys, interactive workshops and individual interviews.

Lochmueller Group Senior Planner, Kathryn Shackelford, presented the final draft of the plan for review at a Sept. 23 meeting at StoneGate Center.

A comprehensive plan provides the framework for securing state and federal funding for a community's future projects. As a result of the city's previous plan, Bedford won the Stellar Communities Award in 2013.
