# Flea, Tick & Hearworm Prevention in Dogs



#### Flea & Heartworm

## revolution (selamectin)

Once a month Topical Must be 6 weeks or older

- Kills adult fleas, & prevents flea eggs from hatching
- Prevention of heartworm disease
- Treats & controls ear mites & sarcoptic mange

# Trifexis (spinosad+milbemycin oxime) Once a month

Must be 8 weeks or older

- Chewable tablet Kills fleas & prevents infestations
- Prevention of heartworm disease
- Treats & controls roundworm, hookworm, & whipworm
- Starts killing fleas in 30 mins.



Must be 4 weeks or older

Chewable tablet

- Inhibits flea egg development, is not an Adulticide
- Prevention of heartworm disease
- Kills & controls roundworm, hookworm, & whipworm

Must be 8 weeks or older Once a month Topical

- Treatment & control of fleas, ticks, chewing lice, & sarcoptic mites
- **Waterproof**
- 👺 Long lasting



Must be 8 weeks or older Chewable tablet

- Kills fleas before they can lay eggs
- Prevents flea infestations
- Treatment & control of American Dog, Black-legged, Lone Star ticks

Do NOT use in dogs that are pregnant, lactating, or have a history with seizures

## CERTIFECT

Must be 8 weeks or older Topical

- Detaches ticks when applied
- Kills adult fleas, flea eggs & larvae, & chewing lice
- 👺 Rapidly starts killing within 6 hours
- Waterproof

#### K9 ADVANTIX®

Must be 7 weeks or older Once a month Topical

- Repels & kills ticks
- Repels & kills fleas before they lay eggs
- 🔀 Repels & kills mosquitoes
- Repels & prevents blood feeding by biting flies
- **Waterproof**
- NOT recommended in households with cats.
  Unless you quarantine the dog until hair
  where advantix was put is completely dry



#### Heartworm

Heartgard (ivermectin/pyrantel)

Must be 6 weeks or older

Once a month Chewable tablet

- Prevention of heartworm disease
- Treatment of roundworms and hookworms

Must be 6 months or older

# ProHeart 6 (moxidectin)

Every 6 months Injection SQ

- Prevention of heartworm disease
- Treatment of common hookworms
  - Safe for pregnant and lactating females, breeding males, and ivermectinsensitive collies

Must be 8 weeks or older

## (ivermectin/pyrantel pamoate/praziquantel)

Once a month Chewable tablet

Prevention of heartworm disease

Treatment of roundworms, hookworms, & tapeworms
