MEMBERSHIP

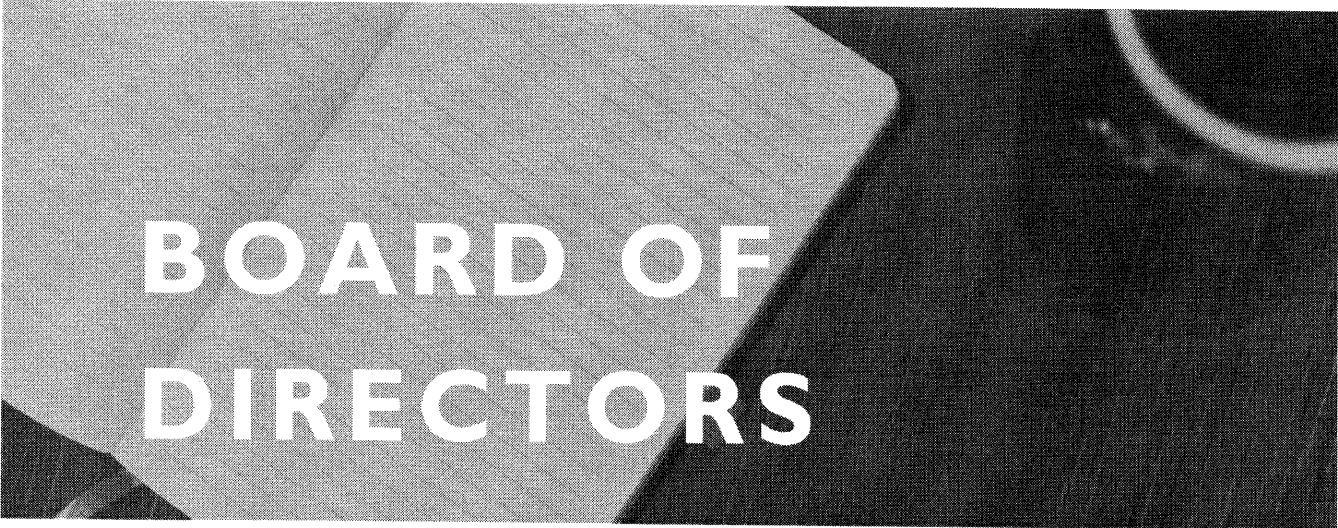
Membership in the BCPA supports public safety initiatives in Bloomington. The \$25 annual membership is tax-deductible.
