The Trinity United Church of Christ, Elliston Church Council met on October 10th, 2016 at 7:00 pm. Amy Mathews, President called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. and Pastor Kyle opened with prayer. Those in attendance were as follows: President – Amy Mathews, Vice President – Ed Gahler, Recording Secretary – Desirae McCloskey, Financial Secretary, Nyla Denman, Elders - Connie Gahler, Trustees – Doug Avery, Marty Hoeft, Steve Turnow and Dale Bodnar, Deacons – Dwayne Hoeft and Jim Buhro. Meeting minutes from the council meeting on 9/16/2016 were read during the meeting. Motion to accept the minutes for the past meeting was made by Ed Gahler, 2nd by Dwayne Hoeft. MC. Secretary Report:

- Quarterly distributions were made from the benevolence fund:
 - \$500 Arc of Ottawa County
 - \$250 Cherry Street Mission
 - \$250 Family House

Financial Report:

- Financial information was reviewed for the prior month. Dale Bodnar moved to accept the financial report. Jim Buhro 2nd. MC.
- 2017 Budget needs to be worked on and presented in the November councils meeting. It will then be presented to the congregation afterwards.

Pastor Report:

- Gym floor has been re-waxed. Kitchen, bathroom and downstairs basement still needs finished. Thanks to Kyle for taking on this task!
- Pastor Kyle is still looking into outdoor signage for the church, which will replace the signs that are currently looking outdated. He is going to reach out to Zion to see if they are interested in getting new signs as well.
- Three weddings and one baptism were performed since the last meeting.

- One baptism currently scheduled for the following month.
- Ed Gahler/Pastor Kyle will be purchasing additional tables for the church, as some need to be replaced. Still in the works.
- Still waiting to hear back from stain glass window company for further timing and details planning to come towards the end of November/December.
- Wanted to remind members of the following dates:
 - Antique roadshow rescheduled for November 13th

Committee Reports:

Worship – Currently working on the Sunday service (Pat Cannon) and the Wednesday (Analisa Turnow) service while Kyle is out. Anyone looking to assist would be greatly appreciated and should see Jane Gahler.

Zion has asked if we were still interested in having a joint Thanksgiving meal. We would be happy to host the meal on November 20th at 11 am, along with a food drive.

EFY –Still looking for teachers! PLEASE SIGN UP! For all of those interested in teaching either one Sunday or several Sunday. Please sign up outside the door.

Mission – Boo Festival on October 23rd at 4 pm. Church & Ministry –

- Ed and Jane are moving forward on interviewing for the janitorial job based on their past experience, one is currently interested that will be interviewed.
- Note All paid employee wage increases will always be in October, no matter when the employee has started, due to the approval of the wage increase and the completion of the next year's budget preparation.
- One year review was performed for Kyle (earlier than one year due to potential wage increases). Kyle's review was given and he received an Outstanding rating.
 - 1) Increase of 3%, which equates to \$1,200
 - 2) \$500 Visa gift-card was also given

- 3) The continuation of the \$150 a month gas card will continue as well.
- Rhonda review was given and she received an Outstanding rating.
 - 1) Approve \$1 an hour increase
 - 2) \$250 gift card was given
 - The continuation of the \$100 a month gas card will continue as well.

Search Committee – November 8th will be the next (and last) meeting at 6:30, with a dinner for all and their spouse.

Youth Events – We want to have more events for the youth, therefore wanted to make everyone aware of the following events that are currently planned.

- October 23rd 4 pm -8 pm Boo Festival
- November 6th 4 pm -8 pm Youth Progressive Dinner

We will be asking for people to help and to volunteer your time to make these events memorable for our youth.

Trustees -

- Need to look into snow removal this upcoming winter season.
- The outside around the front of the church has been dug out and fixed (tree roots were getting clogged in the drainage). Therefore, now that the outside has been fixed, the basement wall/stairwell can now be fixed.
- Roof has been replaced at the parsonage due to the state of the roof and the current condition the roof was under.

Parsonage Committee - Appraisal has been done and the committee has determined an as-is asking price of \$100k. The current tenants have accepted the appraisal of \$100k. We will give Ed the authority to sign the purchase agreement. Therefore, council will now present to the congregation for their approval. Church council will also give Ed Gahler permission to be the legal representative and have the authority to sign all paper work for the sale of the parsonage property.

Old Business:

 Reminder to council to contact Bob Jensen for annual maintenance of the front doors. Ed Gahler will follow up with Mr. Jensen for next steps, if any.

New Business:

- Congregational meeting has been set for December 4th. A outline of the congregation meeting will be presented at the November meeting.
- A discussion was held relative to the weekly payment a visiting pastor receives. After much discussion a motion was made by Marty Hoeft to raise the weekly payment from \$100 to \$150. 2nd by Nyla Denman. MC
- Marty Hoeft discussed the method of backup the church is currently using for the computer system (which is a manual process performed by Rhonda). Marty has looked into a backup system which would include anti-virus, backup system, and IT support for \$100 a month. Discussion was held and it was determined this added cost would be taken into consideration during the compilation of the 2017 budget.
- Church camp will be held from January 20-22, 2017. Full payment is due BEFORE our arrival. Due to the increase in interested families, the \$5 offering the next couple months will be important in order for the church to pay for the children of the church to attend.
- Marty Hoeft made a motion to utilize money within the memorial fund to purchase an outside life-size nativity scene for the church. Price is \$987 plus shipping. 2nd by Doug Avery. MC. There will also be information included within the bulletin for church members to purchase additional animals for the nativity scene.

A second was made by Janene Lattimore. All in favor were asked to say "I", with the majority of the congregation doing so. Note there were no individuals who opposed the motion. Motion carried.
