Entry Fee of \$1 per animal will be collected.

Rules and Regulations for the Show

- Any breed or cross-breed of goat may show. Bedding is not provided. **No straw! A limited number of pens will be provided. Once these are filled we will have a tie out area for exhibitors.**
- All classes will be shown by weight. Animals will be weighed from 1:00PM until 4:00PM prior to the beginning of the show. All goats must be a **minimum weight of 30 pounds** to be exhibited.
- All goats will be divided into one of three divisions: **Market Kid, Doe Kid, or Yearling Doe**
- All goats must have a **Scrapie tag and Current Health Papers** in order to show. Scrapie tags can be obtained from your local USDA office. Registered goats need to be tattooed correctly and have matching papers.
- All wether kids must show no evidence of having testicular tissue. Animals possessing this tissue will not be allowed to show.
- Marked and Doe Kids must possess all milk teeth. Wethers with any yearling teeth will not be allowed to show, and does having one but not more than four yearling teeth will be shown in the Yearling Doe division. Does possessing over three yearling teeth will be allowed to show in the Yearling Doe division Championship show only.
- All goats must be polled or have their horns tipped or cushioned with a material to help prevent injury to the exhibitor.
- Show management reserves the right to disqualify any animal that exhibits signs of disease regardless.

- Franklin County Fair is not responsible for any accidents or injury that should occur within the duration of this show.
- The show will begin with four showmanship classes. These will be broken down into Peewee, Junior, Junior High and Senior High.
