February 10, March 10, April 14, May 12 and June 9

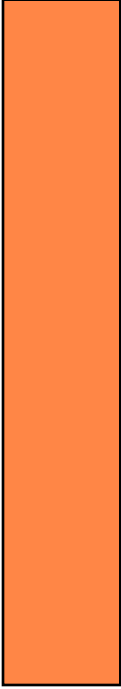
