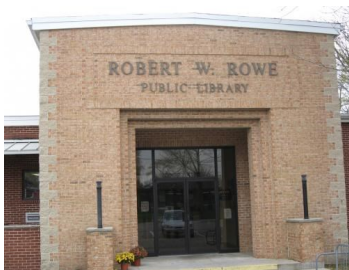

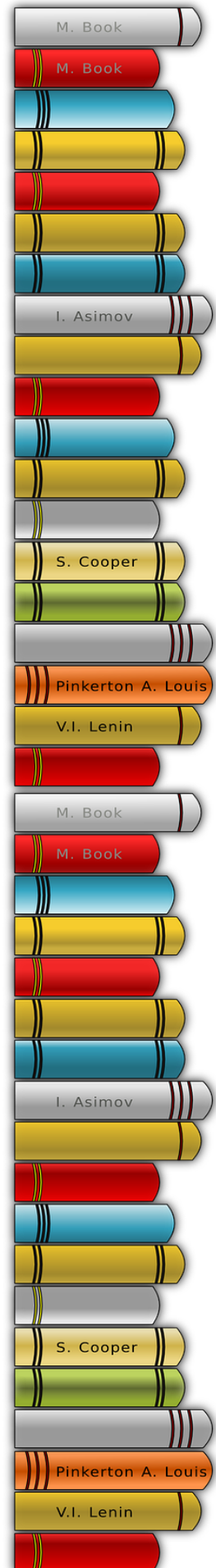

Resident Reminders:

During these cold months, the Sheridan Police Department has received several complaints of Dogs being left outside in the cold.



The Humane Care for Animals Act of Illinois (510 ILCS 70) prohibits dogs/cats to be exposed to extreme heat or cold for prolonged periods of time that would place the animal at risk for Hypothermia, Hyperthermia, Frostbite or other injury. Please also refer to Chapter 21-Animals of the Municipal Code of Sheridan to view the Village Ordinance.

Please be mindful and kind to your pets when putting them outside whether in a fence or tethered.

BUILDING PERMITS ARE REQUIRED

in the Village of Sheridan.

Please check to see if your home project will require permitting!

Call Village Hall @ 815-496-2251 or check our website under the Zoning tab and view the Zoning Ordinance Book to find out if your project will require a permit to be issued before beginning work.



JUNK VEHICLES

Village Ordinance states a “Junk Vehicle” is defined as a vehicle that is not in running condition, is not currently licensed or currently insured. Village Ordinance can be found on our website at www.sheridan-il.us under the Municipal Code of Sheridan.



It is not our desire to enforce this ordinance or cause fines and inconvenience to residents, however to keep Sheridan clean Zoning Enforcement will take place if necessary.
