Rules

- I. This contest is open to students from 4th through 12th grades. Entries will be separated into Junior (4th-8th grades) and Senior (9th-12th grades) age divisions.
- II. Entries may fall into, but are not limited to the following categories: Decorated Garments, Home Accessories, General Crafts, Ceramics, Woodworking, Drawing/Painting, or other artistic or crafting medium.
- III. Entries must be made completely by the child who's name appears on this form. Age-appropriate supervision and instruction are allowed.
- IV. Entries will be displayed until the end of the Chattahoochee Mountain Fair and may be picked up at the Habersham County Extension office the week after the fair closes. Larger entries will be handled at the discretion of the event coordinator.
- V. There is no charge for this event, however, an entry form is required for each entry.
- VI. If any entry is deemed inappropriate by the fair committee or its representatives, that entry will be removed from the judging and from the display area.
- VII. All entry **forms** must be received by the **Habersham County Extension** Office by September 1, 2021. Forms may be faxed to 706-754-5611. You may mail them to **555 Monroe St., Unit 50, Clarkesville, GA 30523**. Mailed entries must be postmarked by August 27, 2021. Or you may drop them off at that address between 8:00-12:00 and 1:00-5:00 Monday-Friday.
- VIII. Entries may be delivered to the fairgrounds between 4:00 and 6:30 PM on Thursday, September 9, 2021 or to the Habersham County Extension office before then. Entries must stay at the fair until Saturday, September 18, 2021.
- IX. The Fair Committee will not be responsible for lost or stolen entries.
- X. All entries must be labeled in an inconspicuous spot with the child's name, school, and grade.
- XI. The Fair Committee reserves the right to cancel this competition if there is a lack of participation.
- XII. Entry into fair contests provides the entrant free admission to the fair on Saturday, September 11, 2021. Multiple entries does not equal multiple admissions. Parents and other family or friends will not be admitted free of charge. We must receive your entry in order to grant access to the fair.

- XIV. Students may only enter two (2) pieces for judging.
- XV. Entries may be picked up at the Extension office after the fair. All entries not picked up by September 30, 2021 will become property of the Chattahoochee Mountain Fair and may be subject to destruction, use in promotional materials, or any other use deemed fit by the fair committee.
