# Field Trial Committee Report

Reflections on the Natural Skills Test Demonstration

The Field Trial Committee held a Natural Skills Test Demonstration at Purina Farms on September 15, 2018.

Purina Farms did a great job setting up snow fencing and a secure gate in a shady area, set between two stands of trees.

We had 9 dogs...1 Smooth and 8 wire. The enclosure had two pallets with brush and straw; each had a wire cage hidden with a live rabbit in one. Wild rabbit scent was spread around each pallet.

We had two judges with clipboards that made notes on:

- \*Sociability
- \*Search Test \*Olfact Test
- \*Predatory drive

Once the judges saw that a dog wasn't searching, using his scenting ability and exhibiting prey drive, the Judges told the owners to help direct the dog to the pallet where the rabbit was hidden. If this had been a Portuguese TAN, none of the dogs would have had a Pass. There were 3 dogs that exhibited some of the searching and using their scenting to approach the pallet where the rabbit was located. Our Judges were lenient and gave those dogs a Pass.

The videos that Bud Hidlay kindly took for us and put up on the PPPA website were sent to Nuno Ferro. Nuno's response was expected. He gave some helpful suggestions on what an ideal setup would be: more vegetation, slightly larger and a fixed permanent fence. He also suggested that the Judges be on opposite sides of the enclosure.

He was disappointed that these Podengos didn't exhibit much hunting ability and prey drive. Actually those of us there from the Committee: Kim Ragsdale, Harriet Haydon, Karen Sage and myself (Sandy Gillen) were disappointed as well. Karen noted that the dogs looked unsure about what they were supposed to do and looked back at their owners for directions.

The Judges told the owners to use the time in the enclosure as a training moment to direct them to where the rabbit was and encourage their dogs to go after the rabbit. We had a very laid back domestic rabbit. The dogs were curious, but not a lot of prey drive.

Those of us on the Committee have been discussing the dog's behaviors.

\*Our dogs are mostly pets that live with us in our homes.


\*We train our Pequenos to look to us for directions.




- 1. As stated above you must be a member of the PPPA and in good standing






