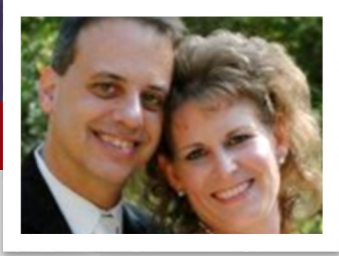


# 7-S MINISTRIES

## ***Biographical Sketches***

### **Todd's Testimony and Call to Ministry**

I was raised in a Christian home and accepted Jesus Christ as my personal Saviour at the age of 12 while attending a youth rally. After high school I attended Northern Kentucky University. I began working and transferred to Cincinnati, Ohio, where I attended Hilltop Baptist Church. I served faithfully in many capacities and in 2001 I surrendered to preach the gospel. One week later, my father passed away. I continued working in various ministries and an opportunity arose to help out a veteran missionary in Alaska to start an Awana program and train others for a children's church in twelve churches. I accepted the position. Upon finalizing the paperwork, my church decided to vote to separate from the Southern Baptist Convention and become an Independent Fundamental Baptist Church. Although I had accepted the position, I too voted yes to separate from SBC due to the fact that SBC wanted to use the Holman Bible instead of the King James. Because of this stand, I was not able to go to Alaska. I stayed with my home church and helped my pastor plant and work a church in Hamilton, Ohio. This church was planted through soul winning and the bus ministry.

In 2003, I moved to Texas to attend IBC/Berean Bible College with the goal of planting a church with an orphanage in Nuevo Laredo, Mexico. This door was closed, and in 2006 I joined Trinity Baptist Church in Arlington, Texas and enrolled in Trinity Baptist Bible College. I immediately got involved serving in many ministries at Trinity. In 2012, I met and married my wife, Ginger, who has been faithfully serving at Trinity Baptist Church for 15 years. The Lord spoke to both of our hearts about full time service in the area of ministering to the local churches across America. We are excited to be serving the Lord together and want to please Him in all that we do. We believe that God wants to use us to help build and strengthen others for His Glory.

### **Ginger's Testimony and Call to Ministry**

I was raised in a Christian home with two loving parents that love the Lord and have been faithful in serving the Lord in their local church my entire life. When I was 7 years old, I attended a youth camp in Ohio. I was too young to be a camper, but because my parents were counselors that year, I was taken along. One night during a chapel song service, they were singing "If You're Saved and You Know It", and I sat down and began to cry, knowing I was not saved and on my way to hell. Being raised in church all my life I knew I needed to accept Jesus as my Saviour. That evening I went forward during the invitation and asked Jesus to save me. The following Sunday I was baptized by my pastor, Bro. Troy Todd.

For as long as I can remember, I have loved church and serving the Lord. As an adult, I too was serving the Lord in many capacities in my church just as my parents had. It was during a Stewardship Conference held at my church, Trinity Baptist, that God spoke to my heart about giving it all to Him. 1. **SORTING**: *To Provide Knowledge*
  - Choosing the right people for the right ministry
  - What ministry best fits you
  - Moses Tabernacle (Tent maker made curtains not Gold Trim)
  
2. **STRAIGHTENING**: (Setting in order): *To Provide Training*
  - Get a plan for each Ministry
  - Match the goal to the goal of God & the church
  
3. **SYSTEMATIC CLEANING** (Shine): *To Purge Unnecessary Waste*
  - Cleansing yourself
  - Remove sin from your life
  - Bible reading, praying, etc...
  
4. **STANDARDIZE**: *To Become in One Accord*
  - Training & church rules
  - Church standards
  - Church Bi-Laws
  
5. **SUSTAIN**: *To Produce Trained Workers & Continued Growth*
  - Pick one (Leadership type) ministry
  - Multi- task - add two to three smaller ministries
  - Train new converts how to serve II Timothy 2:2
  
6. **SAFETY & SECURITY**: *To Provide a Safe Environment*
  - Bus safety
  - Driver safety
  - Commitment forms
  - Never be alone
  - How to properly hug and show love to a child
  
7. **SATISFACTION**: *To produce results!*
  - To bring more souls to Christ
  - Revival
  - To hear, "Well done thou good and faithful servant"
