-Thursday, March 29th is Holy Thursday and we will be holding our annual all-school retreat.

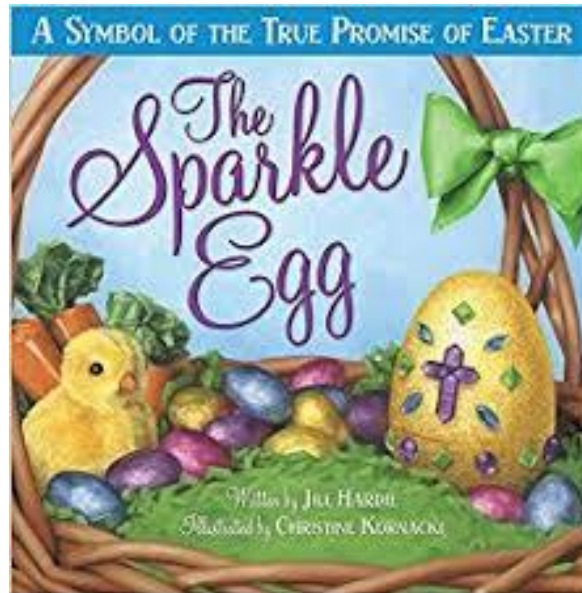
-Friday, March 30th is Good Friday. We begin Spring Break on this solemn day.

Enrichment Update

Did you know our school has an Enrichment Program? Mrs. Kovacs is here once a week working with our students in third through eighth grade. Here are some of the things the students in this program have been working on in the second and third quarters.

Third, Fourth, Fifth Grades (not all grades completed the same activities):

- Cardinal directions and maps
- Math challenges and puzzles
- Graphing information
- Money riddles/challenges using coins
- Collaborative story writing: one person writes intro with characters, then another student develops setting, then plot, and solution...
- Liquid measurement
- Penny boats, mass/volume/density
- Weight bearing roof tops (Which design is better for your climate)
- Mini research projects with short oral reports
- Decimal Math Designs and calculations (decimals, percentages and fractions)
- Perimeter calculations

Sixth, Seventh and Eighth Grades (not all grades completed the same activities):

- Mini oral reports
- Cams and axels in rotary motion
- Penny boats, mass/volume/density
- Marble roller coasters incorporating friction to create the slowest moving marble without it stopping
- Research projects on a current event or issue and “creative” presentation
