GERMANY SOCIETY CHARTERS THE BARON VON STEUBEN CHAPTER IN GERMANY FOR ITS PRIMARY MEMBERS

The Germany Society, National Society of the Sons of the American Revolution has a new chapter in the Germany!

In mid-September 2023 John H. Bredenfoerder, President of the Germany Society traveled to Berlin, Germany. His mission was to present the new chapter charter to the primary members of the Germany Society and swear in the officers of the Baron Von Steuben Chapter.



He arrived along with his First Lady Laurie on Friday, September 15th. They were welcomed with a cordial meet & greet chartering dinner which was held at a popular local Berlin restaurant.

On Saturday, the Bredenfoerders were given a tour of Sans Souci, the palace of Fredrich the Great. Floral tributes were also placed by the group at the statues of Baron Von Steuben in both Pottsdam, and



Cincinnati SAR gathered with a group of 80 on Independence Day, 2023 in Washington Park

The park is located in downtown Cincinnati, OH and at 2 PM on 7/4/2023 many gathered to bring recognition and honor to 54 forgotten Revolutionary War Patriots. Nowadays, Washington Park is a community gathering place, but 150 years ago it was a cemetery. In a county where as many as 55 Revolutionary War veterans were buried. On this day Five of the 54 soldiers were honored, the remaining 49 will be entered in future ceremonies leading up to the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence in July of 2026. On a drizzly Saturday afternoon on October 21st, 2023 in the Myers Cemetery in Goshen Ohio members of the Sons of the American Revolution (SAR) hosted a Patriot Grave Marking event sponsored by the Central District of the Sons of the American Revolution's new Vice President Steve Hinson. The weather may have dampened our attire, however never our spirit. We were honored to have the President General John L Dodd of the National SAR participate in the Central District events on Saturday. He addressed and inspected the Color Guard participants at the start of the event. Our Germany Society Secretary Dr. Michael Gunn Emceed the event where six patriots were honored. They are:

- ~ Ludwig F. Fryburger (1745-1802) a Private with PA.
- ~ Daniel R. Roudabush (1749-1804) Rendered Service in the Revolution.
- ~ Johann Jacob Stroup, Sr. (1767-1862) a Soldier in the Revolution.
- ~ Lewis Fryberger (-1845) served one year in the Revolution.
- ~ Jacob Reader (1757-1842) a Soldier in the Revolution.
- ~ And A. Simmons (1747-1827) a soldier whose grave site is unknown here.

Another significant part of the event was the presentation of ceremonial wreaths from the many SAR, DAR, CAR and local civic groups who participated in this event, 42 wreaths were placed by attendees who included six SAR General Officers in addition to our President General.
