Christmas Gift Bags

Social Ministry is once again asking the generous members of Immanuel for donations to assemble Christmas gift bags for the residents of the Community Shelter. The Community Shelter has beds for 16 men and 15 women who have found themselves homeless and have no other place to go. They may stay at the shelter for 45 days, while the staff works with them to find more permanent housing and employment.

We are forming a Thrivent Action Team. Thrivent Financial will provide \$250 seed money for the Christmas bags to help the residents enjoy Christmas.

Denise Arnold designed cloth tote bags to use as the gift bags, and the women of Immanuel help sew themtogether.

There will be a <mark>signup sheet for items needed</mark>for the gift bags in the side entrance of the church. Please put your donations in the box by <u>December 10th.</u>

Monetary donations will gladly be accepted as well, for any additional items needed. Please mark your donations "*Community Shelter Christmas*" and put in the collection or send to church office by December 10th

We'll also need help packing the gift bags on December 17thafter church, so they can be delivered to The Shelter before Christmas.

The Shelter has also requested feminine hygiene products. These will also be collected for donation, but not part of the gift bags.


