RESOLUTION TO ALLOW LOCAL RESIDENTS TO PROTEST IN WRITING

WHEREAS, the LaGrange Township Board agrees to the following:

Resolution to Allow Local Residents to Protest in Writing.

In order to ease the burden on taxpayers, the assessor and the Board of Review and to ensure that all taxpayers have an equal opportunity to be heard by the Board of review, the Township of LaGrange hereby resolves, according to provisions of MCL 211.30 (7) of the General Property Tax Act, that the Board of Review shall receive letters of protest regarding assessments from resident taxpayers the first Tuesday in March until it adjourns from the public which it meets to hear such protest.

All notices of assessment change and all advertisements of Board of Review meetings are to include a statement that the resident taxpayers may protest by letter to the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the LaGrange Township Board approves Resolution 4-2023, effective January 16, 2023.
