Voter Registration: New registrations and registration changes are permitted at the polling place on Election Day. Identification is required to vote. Bring your Wyoming Driver's License with you or call the County Clerk's office to learn what other identification is acceptable. Provisional ballots will be available at the polls.
PRECINCT 1-1 ballot is a complete sample ballot. Other precinct ballots are partial showing races unique to the precinct.

ExpressVote® Universal Voting System

INFORMATION FOR VOTERS WITH DISABILITIES

Currently in Weston County all polling places are accessible to persons with limited mobility. There will also be at least one (1) ExpressVote® Universal Voting System at every polling location. This allows a person with a disability to mark their ballot with little or no assistance whether they have a visual or dexterity disability and they place their ballot in the DS200 for tabulation. According to Wyoming Statute 22-13-113(a) "...any elector who requires assistance to vote because of blindness, disability or inability to read or write may be given assistance by a person of the elector's choice, other than the elector's employer or an agent of that employer or an officer or agent of the elector's union." There are many reasons a voter may wish to use the ExpressVote® Universal Voting System, please call the county clerk's office for more details.



DS200 Ballot Tabulating Machine

HOW TO VOTE

Instructions for marking a ballot for the DS200 tabulation machine are included on each ballot. When marking your official ballot you **MUST** use the black pen that the election judges provide for you. Please read your ballot very carefully. If you over-vote (vote for more candidates than allowed) the machine will quietly beep and list the office(s) where you over voted. You will need to obtain and mark a new ballot, so please read "Vote For" carefully. You may under vote (vote for fewer candidates than allowed) your ballot without it being returned to you.

ONLY THE PRECINCT RACES IN WHICH CANDIDATES HAVE FILED ARE LISTED BELOW. ALL OTHERS ARE SUBJECT TO WRITE-INS.
