JACK'S CORNER

"HELP, OUR CHILD IS OUT OF CON- TROL!"



Sometimes parents are aware of this fact, but would only express such a heart-wrenching statement to their spouse, or to God.

Sometimes, even very small children are out of control. Or, should we say, 'They are IN control' because they always get their way?

Raising children is certainly no easy task! And, there are no perfect parents. But, we do have excellent advice from inspiration to help us with this enormous undertaking.

Solomon said, "*My son, hear the instruction of your father, and do not forsake the law of your mother*" (Prov. 1:8). This verse lays a responsibility on parents. In order for children to learn, they must be taught.

Most are familiar with another scripture from Solomon, "*Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it.*" Again, parents are given a responsibility to take action.

TWO WAYS TO TRAIN OUR CHILDREN:

- (1) Teach them to respect your authority. Let them know who is in charge in the home by proper love and discipline. "*Correct your son, and he will give you rest; Yes, he will give delight to your soul.*" Parents could make it much easier on themselves by implementing discipline at an early age (Prov. 19:18), and save themselves embarrassment (Prov. 29:15).
- (2) Teach them to respect God's authority. God's word has always demanded that parents instruct their children in spiritual matters. The Israelites were told to teach their children to love God with all their heart, soul, and strength (Deut. 6:4-7). Timothy had developed a genuine faith because of the diligent teaching of his mother and grandmother (2 Tim. 1:5).

In order for children to respect God's authority they must see it in their parents' lives and be taught at home, as well as in the church.
