MEMBERSHIP

At the board meeting on January 25th we revised the dues by laws. These can be found on page 49 in your 2016 roster. Please be aware of what has changed and what remains the same. We will vote on these changes Feb 14th.

** Annual dues shall be \$35.00 for regular members and \$20.00 for associate members, payable upon application for membership and thereafter at the first regular meeting in January.*

** Dues shall become delinquent after March 1, when regular members shall lose voting rights.*

** Regular members renewing their membership by the February General Meeting will receive a \$5.00 discount on their dues.*

** Dues for a new regular member will be \$30 all year. Dues accepted for a new member after October 31st will be credited to the following year and per capita dues shall not be sent to SDCFRW until January of the following year.*

** The fourth bullet item has been eliminated. It read: New regular members joining between June 1 and October 31 shall pay prorated dues in the amount of \$25.00 and for Associate members \$15.00.*

You can also take the Orange line into downtown coming west, still exiting at Civic Center. Go north into the concourse, see the colorful Republican Tent located right smack on the concourse, across from the other party and in front of Golden Hall. Sign-in and say Hello!

At about 10:30 a.m. a large group of happy, new naturalized citizens will come streaming out of the double doors to celebrate with their friends and family. We will be there to greet them and register them as Republicans.

By 12 noon, registrations will be complete, the tent will be packed up and the area cleared. Plan then to celebrate your day's accomplishments at lunch with your teammates.
