
The Stickman No. 30 Puzzlebox (Burl Tile Puzzle)

This puzzle has a single hidden chamber, accessed by manipulating all tiles on both sides to fully complete an intricate burl pattern. A special "runt tile" removes, producing a space for tiles to be manipulated like a traditional sliding tile puzzle. Breaking from tradition, tiles can also be rotated and exchanged from one side of the box to the other through use of its twisting end. A well-hidden trick will also allow them to lift up and rotate into different orientations within the box.

Once this puzzle is solved, internal logic bars can be flipped over and re-inserted to create an entirely different puzzle solving process. This secondary solution can lock tiles in place, so they can't move until neighboring tiles are manipulated into certain positions. Managing to free a locked tile will at times also

indirectly lock yet another tile in place. This adds to the challenge of an already difficult puzzle.

Puzzles were hand-crafted from leopardwood and walnut, with tiles and sides finished with exotic tamo burl. They measure 7.5" x 4.5" x 4.5" and are limited in edition to only 50 completed boxes. Boxes come with fully illustrated instruction books
