Ready to lend a hand, but not sure where you can help? How about Worship Hospitality?

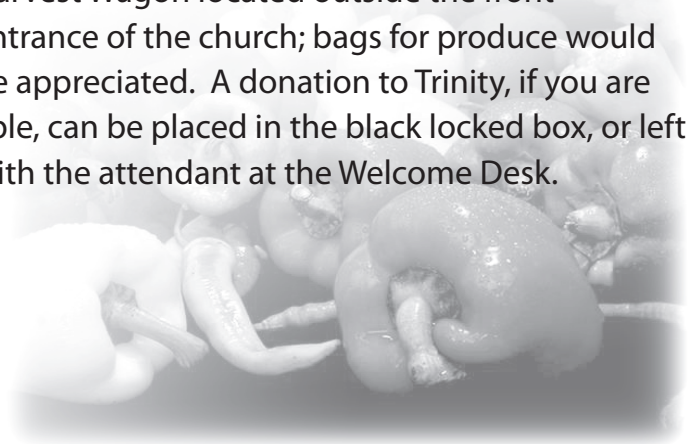

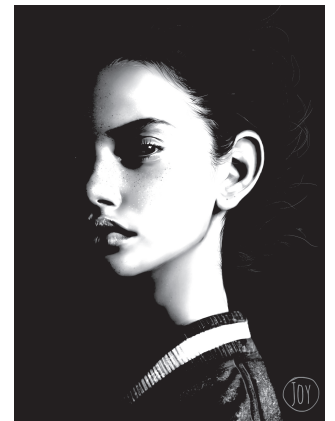
World of Widows (W.O.W)

Madagascar Mission

On Sunday, August 5, our member Bob Jemc spoke to the congregation about the July trip to Madagascar made by Friends of Madagascar Mission (FOMM): our former interim pastor David Lerseth, Bob Jemc, Pastor Eric Svensson, Dale Arnold and Ron and Lorraine Simpson. The flights to and from Madagascar were 20 hours and just over 10,000 miles. Following is a summary of the trip.

We visited two men's prisons and one women's prison; attended two church services at two prisons; attended two baptisms and two confirmations at the women's prison. We visited schools, medical facilities, including schools for the blind and the hearing impaired. We visited the company that is helping with the Drip Irrigation Project.

We attended two church services at regular churches. One of three packed services was three hours long and had a packed house of 3,500 people--10,000 people for a single Sunday! The other church service, which included a graduation, was 10 minutes short of 5 hours.

We now have 43 full Evangelists who performed over 1,154 baptisms. They did 499 confirmations and visited 898 villages by foot. Not only do they minister to people, they also teach them to read.

We have 6 active projects going on in Madagascar. Providing support for evangelists is our first "project". A second project was the new Drip Irrigation Project to help people grow food. They are taught proper usage of the system at two of

the Bible Schools and at Ejeda Hospital. The cost of each micro irrigation system is \$25, the third and fourth projects are those Bible Schools and Ejeda Hospital Nutrition Program. The Bible Schools teach reading and The Ejeda Program helps feed the patients and their families while they are at the hospital.

The Tandroy Bible printing, our fifth project, is just about ready. This included writing down an unwritten dialect producing a dictionary, and 16 years to translate the Bible into the Tandroy dialect.

The 6th Project is the Prison Ministry where people go to church to receive food for the soul, and then rice for the body. If their family does not bring food for them and they didn't get this rice, they would die.

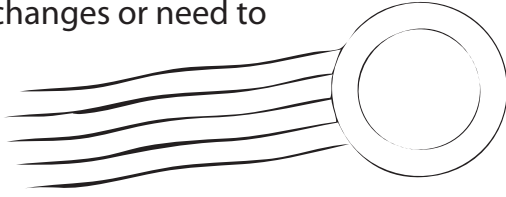

Renewal Service

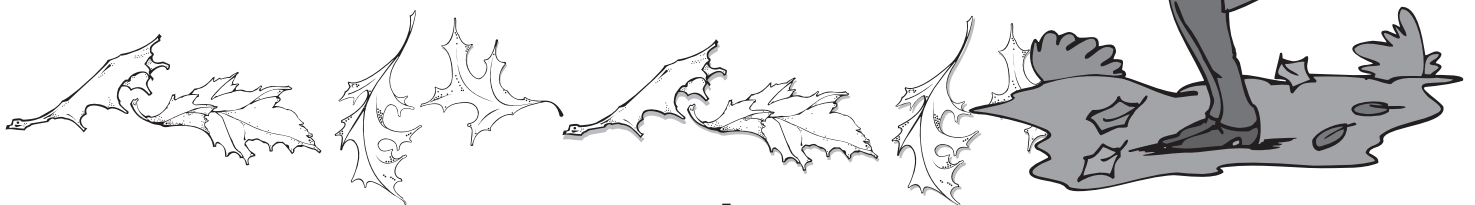

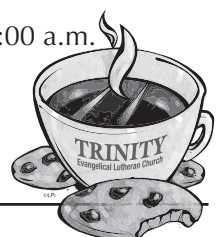

Nan's calling to stewardship

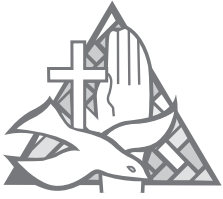
Nan K. was asked by her church to lead a special campaign to pay off the remaining debt on the sanctuary. She consented and made this statement at a worship service:
