**Subject:** End-of-Day COVID-19 Update from Denver Mayor Michael B. Hancock (Monday, April 6)

Good afternoon. A few helpful items:

- Mayor Hancock today extended the City's stay-at-home order through April 30<sup>th</sup>. It was set to expire Saturday. Click [here](#) to read more.
- People took to the parks and other public spaces over the weekend. Many did a good job of physical distancing – but not everyone. Denver enforcement agents have now issued 1,800 warnings to comply with the stay-at-home order and 14 orders to close to non-critical businesses.
- Gov. Polis will be addressing the state with a COVID-19 update at 6:30 p.m. today. Some elected leaders asked the Governor for help today. Click [here](#) to read more.
- British Prime Minister Boris Johnson has been moved into intensive care, while Iran is lifting its national shutdown of businesses.
- More cautious optimism: New York may have seen a plateau in daily deaths.
- Around the world:
  - 1.3 million people sickened
  - **74,000 deaths – up 4,600 from yesterday**
- Across the U.S.:
  - 363,000 people sickened
  - **10,500 deaths – up 900 from yesterday**
- In Colorado:
  - 26,875 people tested
  - 5,172 positive cases
  - 994 hospitalized
  - 54 of 64 counties with positive cases
  - **150 deaths – up 10 from yesterday**
  - 41 outbreaks at residential and non-hospital health care facilities
- In Denver:
  - 873 positive cases
  - **26 deaths – up two from yesterday**
