APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

- 1. A Scholarship Program Packet can be requested from the FYRA Association Secretary.
- 2. The application form must be completed by the student and forwarded to the guidance counselor o or principal. The FYRA Association Secretary should then receive the completed forms from the guidance counselor or principal.
- 3. The following information must be received in the FYRA office by Jan.15th of each year, or as otherwise requested.
- *Application
- *SAT and/or ACT scores/ or exit exam scores
- *Copy of the student's High School grade transcript (9-11)
- *Letter of Reference (completed by guidance counselor, principal, or teachers)
- *Description of community involvement/activities




