Wavyleaf basketgrass is an invasive grass that destroys native forests and damages wildlife habitat. It has been moving into Pennsylvania from infestations in Maryland and Virginia. DCNR is asking the public to report any sightings in Pennsylvania and to help stop it from spreading.



Sticky seeds can be found September through November.

Look for wavy leaves that do not encircle the hairy stem!

Take Action!

- Stay on the trail.
- Seeds are hitchhikers! Remove all seeds from yourself, pets, and gear before leaving the area.
- Walk around patches of this grass, not through them.
